Arena Sheep Per trial: \$55.00 TCN fee, **per trial**: \$10.50

Marked Catalog: \$2.00 (will be e-mailed AFTER completion of Trials)

Same day entries: additional \$10.00 per trial per dog, **if stock available Move ups** will be allowed between trials. See Trial Secretary as soon as possible to complete a Move Up Form.

Note: The CKC TCN Fee of \$10.50 per dog, **per trial** is payable with the entry fee if the entry for the dog does not include the CKC Individual Registration Number or ERN.

In payment of entry fees, the tendering of NSF cheques shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A collection fee of \$30.00 will be added to the amount of any returned cheque. Telephone entries are not accepted by the Trial Secretary. Incomplete entries, entries received without fees and required waivers, or entries received after the advertised closing date will not be accepted. There will be no refund on overpayments or duplicate entries. Please mail entries early to ensure that they are received before the closing date.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors!

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you.

Non-Member Participation Fee:

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charge to a Canadian non-member of the CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: ERN numbers must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded from the CKC website: http://www.ckc.ca

Section 18.1 of the CKC Herding Rules states: The CKC shall not be responsible to any member, person, partnership, club or corporation for any loss, damage or injury arising at or by reason of any herding trial held under any rules adopted by the CKC.

Section 15.7 of the CKC Herding Rules states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club officer, ring steward volunteer or competitor at a herding trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Herding Trials Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

PLEASE NOTE: There have been many changes to the CKC Herding Rules that took effect July 1,2021. Rule books can be found on the CKC website.

PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG!! Dogs must be on leash when not in the arena or the designated exercise area. There is livestock INCLUDING GUARDIAN DOGS on the premises, so please control your dog, close gates behind you if you find them closed, and leave them open if you find them open. Thank you!

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE:

From Henday (Hwy 216) exit at Yellowhead West (Hwy16, Exit 25) to Jasper Drive 36 km to intersection with Hwy 770. Go south 14 km to Hwy 627. Turn Right (west) onto Hwy 627 and proceed 16 km to Range Road 43 and turn left (south). Drive 10 km to the intersection with Twp Rd 510 (paving ends here) and turn right (west).

Continue 0.5 km on Twp Rd 510 to the first intersection (Rge Re 44) and turn left. Take the third driveway on your right (across a cattle gate). Chasin' Dreams Arena is on the right-hand side.

From the south:

North on Hwy 2 to Hwy 19 (at Nisksu). Turn left (west) and go to Hwy 60. Turn right (North) into and through Devon. Continue to Hwy 627 (lights). Turn left (west) and continue to Range Road 43 as above.

COVID REQUIREMENTS

Proceeding with this his trial assumes that Alberta will be at a minimum of Stage 2 of COVID restrictions. Fees will be refunded if event is cancelled due to COVID (less expenses). Updates to Covid specific requirements will be provided in the Judging Schedule.

Social distancing (3 sheep) will be in effect! Masks will be available. If you have been exposed to COVID-19 or are experiencing symptoms, please do not attend.

SPECTATORS

These trials are open to the public to spectate IF Covid restrictions allow. If you would like to come and watch, please leave your dog at **home**. Bring a lawn chair, mosquito spray, sun screen etc. If you have any questions, please feel free to ask any of the trial committee members. Please watch your children at all times, and do not allow them to approach any animals, including dogs, without permission. Be courteous to the exhibitors and stay a minimum of 20 feet away from the fences as you may startle the stock. All dogs must be on leash and visitors are asked to stay within the trial premises so as not to disturb resident dogs or livestock. Anyone not doing so will be asked to leave the premises.

DOG HEALTH CONSIDERATIONS

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

- 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
- 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
- 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the even on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

Associated Herding Clinic

A two-day herding clinic will take place on August 17 & 18, 2022 at the same location. he clinic will be given by Kristin Thomson from Vancouver Island. Kristin has given clinics all across Canada and is very knowledgeable about all aspects of herding. She also works with problem dogs so understands dog behaviour. She is presently working with an awesome Sheltie and has handled many different breeds. Clinic will be limited to 10 working spots and are for all breeds of dogs at any level.
