ENTRY FEES: Tracking Dog Excellent \$100.00 (T.D.X.) C.K.C. Listing fee: \$10.00

ENTRY AND ALTERNATES:

All entries to be sent to the Test Secretary. Entries will be accepted by **Canada Post MAIL ONLY** and with only ONE entry per envelope. Please put the test date on the outside of the envelope.

PAYMENT:

Please make all cheques or money orders payable to: **Rhodesian Ridgeback Club of BC** A listing fee of \$10.00 must accompany an entry fee for all dogs that do not have a registered C.K.C. number.

All fees are to be paid in Canadian funds. US entries may pay fees by money order made payable in Canadian funds or personal cheques for the full amount of the fee.

Personally discounted cheques will NOT be accepted. Please do NOT mark cheques "payable in Canadian funds" or "at par" as the bank does not readily clear these. Tendering an NSF or post-dated cheque will be considered as non-payment of fees and will subject the maker of the cheque to a \$15.00 "handling fee" and possible disciplinary action by the CKC.

Entries will be notified by phone or email that their entry has been received. Entry fees will be returned within 10 days of the day of the test to alternates who did not participate in the test. A competitor may enter more than one dog.

DRAW FOR ENTRY:

A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date and time will take place to determine placement in the test or onto an alternate list. Following the draw positions will be assigned. Once the limit has been reached, all remaining entries will be assigned a position on an alternate list. Entries will be notified by phone or email that their entry has been received and which position their entry occupies.

MEETING PLACE AND DRAW:

Rendezvous is scheduled for sm at **The Grene Wode, 25133 0 Avenue, Langley, BC,** where the draw for tracks will take place. Any Primary entrant(s) who is absent at this time will forfeit their position to the first Alternate present. (Draw for entry will follow Rule 2.2.4. Option2).

BITCHES IN SEASON may compete, however, they will run last. Please advise the Test Secretary upon arrival if this affects you. (Rule 6.7.1)

AWARDS:

Following the tracking test the judge will present ribbons to all successful teams and provide feedback on all the teams.

REFUNDS:

When an entered dog is withdrawn after the closing date, refunds will **only** be permitted when an "Alternate" accepts the vacancy. If a position becomes available, Alternates will be contacted in catalogue order and asked to either accept or decline the position. (i.e. if #1 declines #2 will be contacted etc.)

LIABILITY AND SAFETY:

In attending this test and signing the entry form, all competitors and invited guests acknowledge that they do so at their own risk and that of their dog. They also agree not to hold liable the CKC, Rhodesian Ridgeback Club of BC or its test officials, the judge or the land owners for any loss, damage or injury, however arising, to themselves, their dog or chattels. All reasonable care will be taken for the safety of dogs, handlers and spectators. Use caution alongside roads and be aware of farm equipment.

(RULE 14.7) INDIGNITIES: "It shall be the duty of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant held at an event under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Tracking Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringements of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred."
