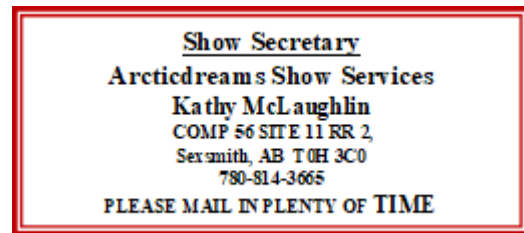

ONLINE ENTRIES ONLY

ENTRIES CLOSE: October 23, 2024 - 11:00 pm MDT

Telephone entries are prohibited except in such circumstances as the Board of Directors of the CKC may otherwise authorize. Online entries and/or credit card payment will be accepted when accompanied by authorized VISA or MASTERCARD or AMEX credit card number. Customers' charges that are declined will be assessed a service charge of \$25.00. Incomplete entries or entries received without fees, or entries received after the advertised closing date will not be accepted. Please enter early to ensure that they are received before the closing date. It is recommended that you phone after you fax your entry to ensure that it was received and readable. All NSF cheques will be subject to a \$45.00 service fee.

*TCN – Temporary Competition Number MUST be obtained from the CKC prior to entering any CKC event. TCNs will replace the previous system of entering events with dogs as “listed” and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). Should you wish to withdraw your entry between the time that you enter and the close of entries you will receive a full refund of entry fees (any Credit Card, Apple Pay, Interac or e-transfer service charges WILL NOT be refunded as per dogshow.ca policy.) Each day is a separate show, and the above fees apply per day, per show except as noted.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will NOT be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. Post-dated cheques will NOT be accepted. Please DO NOT mark cheques “Payable in Canadian Funds” or “At Par” they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank-you.

BORDER CROSSING – A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada, Government Regulations require a Certificate prior to entry into Canada.

Event Registration Number (ERN) Notice

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension to the CKC. An ERN may be obtained by contacting the CKC at: (416) 675-5511 or Fax (416) 675 -6506.

Award of Merit : This award will be made after the Best of Breed judging. A specialty club may offer one Award of Merit for every 10 dogs competing at Best of Breed level. If this award is to be made, it must be in the premium list and the criteria must be fully explained. Where Awards of Merit are offered, these awards are made by the judge after the awarding of Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Winners, Select Dog and Select Bitch from the dogs remaining in the ring.

REGULAR CLASSES

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.
SENIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.
12 – 15 MONTHS	Dogs between 12 months and under 15 months on day of show.
15 – 18 MONTHS	Dogs between 15 months and under 18 months on day of show.
CANADIAN BRED	Dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	Dogs must be <u>owned and handled in the ring by the breeder</u> for this class, but the breeder need not handle the dog for further awards.
OPEN CLASS	For all dogs.
VETERAN CLASS	For all dogs over 7 years of age or older on day of show. These dogs will compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for Best of Breed (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed or neutered.
SPECIALS ONLY	Dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.
FIELD CLASS	This class is optional at specialty shows for breeds that have performance events in the field. Dogs entered in this class must have attained a title or placement in a field trial or test. This class is to be judged prior to Best of Breed judging and the winners in each sex will compete for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.
EXHIBITION ONLY (4 – 6 MOS.)	Puppies 4-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 4-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. <u>These puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial class or parade, but they may compete in Sweepstakes.</u>
BABY PUPPY	Dogs between 4 months and under 6 months on day of show. These puppies are not eligible to compete for championship points, but they may compete in Sweepstakes. Entry in Exhibition Only 4-6 mos. is not required. NO TCN Fee is payable on this class.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Conformation Show Rules and Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by C.K.C. rules. All rules and regulations as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list will also apply to this specialty.
3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the show secretary.
4. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. – CKC rule book, Section 19.7.
5. No dog may be brought on the grounds or premises of an event if it:
 - Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable diseases;
 - Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable diseases within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
 - Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable diseases.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Specialty Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

An error in an age-specified class, date of birth or sex, may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS!

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS!

Effective Jan, 1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **ERN - Event Registration Number**. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **RN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.** A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded from the **CKC website:** www.ckc.ca

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 - 5	6 - 9	10 - 12	13 +
Points Awarded	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

15.1.13 The Board interprets the words “earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges” to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge’s awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

As of July 2021, the rules for awarding of Grand Champion and Grand Champion Excellent have changed. Please see CKC Conformation Rule 15.2 Grand Champion (GCH) & 15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GCHEx) for details.
