The Show Secretary is **NOT RESPONSIBLE** for incorrect information provided by the entrant. Please read your entry carefully before you submit it. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the errors were made. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Rules.

NO POST DATED CHEQUES ACCEPTED. ALL NSF cheques are subject to a charge of **\$25.00**. N.S.F. cheques are considered **Non-Payment of entry fees** and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the shows/trials.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

An annual “Non-member” participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian “non member” of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number.

In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the “non-member” will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the “non-member” participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled.

Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by “Non-CKC” members and are not applicable to CKC members.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US Funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not make cheques “Payable In Canadian Funds”, they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. Agents and handlers please note that the **full name and address of owners MUST be filled in** and to whom ID’s are to be returned. (Section 13.1.2 Dog Show Rules)

CONFORMATION CLASSES

Junior Puppy	A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show.
Senior Puppy	A dog 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show.
12-18 Months	A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show.
Canadian Bred	A dog which was born in Canada.
Bred by Exhibitor	A dog owned and handled by the breeder.
Open Class	A dog 6 months of age or older
Specials Only	Dogs who are Canadian Champions.
Exhibition Only	Dogs 6 months of age and over not in competition.

CONFORMATION MOVING UP TO SPECIALS

A dog individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirement for a Championship in accordance with CKC Rules, after the closing date and time for the show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to “specials Only”, providing the request is submitted to

the Show Secretary in WRITING and on the appropriate form at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. When one or more Championship shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving a Class dog to Specials must be made a minimum one hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up.

Champion & Championship Points ~ Chapter 1 Section 1 ~ A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of Championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded WINNERS also places in the Group.

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show. **NOTE: In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for Championship points.**

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require and Events Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog’s Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. Ensure that you provide the CKC with your full return address to enable the ERN to be sent to you
4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA/MasterCard number and expiry date, the card holders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number **MUST** be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as “LISTED”, however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

RULES & RULE BOOKS

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or participant at any event held under CKC Rules, is not subjected to indignities of any kind. The Show Committee shall promptly report any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of report, indicating that this has occurred.

No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing to favour his/her entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this Rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act (Section 4.1.6 Dog Show rules)

No person shall enter or exhibit a dog under a judge where that judge has owned, conditioned, sold, handled, held under lease or boarded within 6 months prior to the date of the show at which he/she officiates as a Judge. This rule shall apply regardless of whether the judge benefited in any way from any of the aforementioned activities. (Section 4.1.7 dog Show rules).

A copy of the Rules pertaining Dog Shows and/or Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club 1-416-675-5511. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to know the rules pertaining to these events.

Note: The precincts of this show ~ the rings and 3 feet surrounding the rings.

General Rules

1. The Show Superintendent will be in complete charge of these events, which are governed by CKC rules.
2. All Judging will commence at 9:00 a.m. unless entries warrant an earlier or later start time. Group Judging will commence on completion of Breed Judging within each Group. **PROVIDING TIME ALLOWS**, a break at the end of each group will allow for photographs to be taken. No two groups will be judged at the same time.
3. "Double Handling" will not be tolerated. The Superintendent reserves the right to request those exhibitors doing so to leave the site.

4. The Oromocto Kennel Club will use all due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators
5. The Oromocto Kennel Club will not be responsible for any equipment left on the show site.
6. "Puppy For Sale" and "Dog For Sale" signs will not be permitted on the site.
7. There will be no prong or spike collars permitted at this venue. Abuse of any kind will not be tolerated.
8. Dogs not entered in competition or on exhibition are not permitted within the precincts.
9. Children, accompanied by an adult, are welcome at our shows. However, please do not allow them to be unsupervised.
10. There will be portable washrooms only for show exhibitors.
11. If you are planning to use air conditioners, fans etc, please supply your own power; i.e, generator. We CANNOT guarantee power or water at the Show site.
12. **ALL EXHIBITORS WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEAN-UP ON THE SHOW SITE AND THE SURROUNDING AREAS FOR THEIR OWN DOGS OR DOGS THEY ARE HANDLING. ANYONE CAUGHT NOT CLEANING UP AFTER THEIR DOGS WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM SHOWING THEIR DOG OR DOGS AT THIS EVENT.**
