CONFORMATION CLASSES

REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES (divided by sex):

BABY PUPPY CLASS: This class shall be for any dog 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show

12 TO 18 MONTHS - Shall be for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the Specialty.

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. (Champions of any country excluded)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler MUST be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs and shall be divided as follows:

Open class is divided by colour as follows: Open Black, Open Blue, Open Brindle, Open Fawn, Open Harlequin, Open Mantle – indicate colour on entry form

VETERANS CLASS: Shall be for all dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the Specialty. SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR COMPETITION IN THIS CLASS. Classes will be divided into 7 – 9 years of age on the day of the show and 9 years and older on the day of the show

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class MAY NOT COMPETE in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

NON-REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES: (Friday ONLY)

Note: Any dog entered in a Non-Regular class MUST also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only.

STUD DOG & GET: This class shall be comprised of the stud dog and 2 or more of his get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. Stud must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular Class. Dogs entered in the Stud Dog and Get class may be spayed/neutered, and must be entered in a Regular class as outlined in these rules or for Exhibition Only.

BROOD BITCH & PROGENY: This class shall have the same requirements as the Stud Dog and Get class. Dogs entered in the Brood Bitch and Progeny class may be spayed/neutered, and must be entered in a Regular class as outlined in these rules or for Exhibition Only.

BRACE CLASS: Shall be for two dogs (not necessarily the same sex), (Note: effective January 1, 2006 – identical ownership NO LONGER applies). Spayed or neutered dogs may compete in this class but must be entered in a **REGULAR** conformation class or for exhibition only

TEAM CLASS: is open to any 4 Great Danes of either sex. Spayed or neutered dogs may compete in this class but must be entered in a **REGULAR** conformation class or for **EXHIBITION ONLY**

PARADE OF TITLEHOLDERS: is open to Great Danes of either sex which have attained a Canadian Championship and/or a Canadian Title in Obedience or Tracking Degree. Dogs entered in Parade of Titleholders must also be entered in a **REGULAR** Class or for **EXHIBITION ONLY**

PARADE OF VETERANS: is open to Great Danes of either sex aged 7 years or older on July 22, 2011. Dogs entered in Parade of Veterans must also be entered in a **REGULAR** Class or for **EXHIBITION ONLY**

ALTERED CLASSES ((Friday & Saturday)

Are open to Great Danes of either sex, over 6 months of age on July 26, 2013 which have been sexually altered by veterinarian procedure. Altered dog Championship points will be awarded as per Section 15

UNOFFICIAL CLASS (Friday Only)

GENERATIONS: is open to three or more generation families with one exhibit from each generation, exhibited from oldest to youngest of either sex. Spayed/neutered CKC/AKC registered dogs are eligible and ownership need not be identical. A separate entry form **MUST** be submitted for each dog entered, but only one entry fee for each generation family. Dogs entered in Generations must also be entered in a **REGULAR** Class or for **EXHIBITION ONLY**

OBEDIENCE CLASSES (For Great Danes Only)

OBEDIENCE CLASSES: REGULAR

The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class.

BRACE CLASS- section 16.6 is open to any 2 dogs of any breed and of either sex that has attained not less than a C.D. title in Canada. It is not necessary that the same person own both dogs, nor that they be of the same breed.

9 Dogs entered in NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL CLASSES **MUST** be entered in a Regular/Official class or for "Exhibition Only".

PAYMENT OF FEES

Entries may be paid by personal cheque, bank draft, money order, Visa or MasterCard. PLEASE DO NOT SEND CASH IN THE MAIL!!!

Tendering of NSF cheques/Credit is considered non-payment and is punishable by CKC disciplinary action. Telephone entries (excluding faxed entries) are prohibited.

OVERPAYMENT of entry fees WILL NOT be refunded. To comply with CKC, no entries will be accepted, altered, cancelled, or substituted after the official closing date and time for entries (except as provided for in Chapter 13, Section 13.4 of the Dog Show Rules).

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will NOT be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. Post-dated cheques will NOT be accepted. Please DO NOT mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank-you.

BORDER CROSSING – A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada, Government Regulations require a Certificate prior to entry into Canada.

Event Registration Number (ERN) Notice

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension to the CKC. CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows;

DOGS COMPETING*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
POINTS AWARDED	0	1	2	3	4	5

*includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; (2) a two point win awarded either at the breed or group level; and (3) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

EXTRACTS FROM THE CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

JUDGES – SECTION 4.1.3

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively carried out.

SHOW OFFICIALS – SECTION 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.3

Entry forms received by the CKC, which are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information may result in awards being cancelled.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- registered with the CKC
- have an Event Registration Number
- eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN)

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

DISQUALIFICATIONS – SECTION 14.1.4

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

1. THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PERSON FROM THE SHOW. THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT SHALL HAVE FULL CONTROL OF THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS, WHICH WILL BE GOVERNED BY CKC RULES.
 2. ANY DOG EXCUSED BY THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT OR VETERINARIAN FOR ANY REASON SHALL NOT, COMPETE IN ANY CLASS FOR ANY AWARDS FOR THE BALANCE OF THE SHOW.
 3. THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL USE DUE CARE AND DILIGENCE FOR THE WELFARE OF DOGS AND EXHIBITORS, BUT WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR, OR ASSUME ANY LIABILITY IN THE EVENT OF ACCIDENT OR MISFORTUNE TO EITHER DOGS, EXHIBITORS, SPECTATORS OR VENDORS.
 4. DOGS MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 1 HOUR PRIOR TO THE JUDGING OF THEIR BREED.
 5. THE OWNER OF A DOG ENTERED IN THESE SHOWS IS ENTIRELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ERROR IN ENTERING HIS/HER DOG REGARDLESS OF HOW OR BY WHOM THE ENTRY WAS MADE.
 6. EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR DOGS AND EQUIPMENT LEFT AT THE SHOW GROUNDS.
 7. DOGS ARE TO BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY, NOT IN VICINITY OF SHOW RINGS
 8. ALL RECREATIONAL UNITS WILL HAVE BUCKETS UNDERNEATH FOR THEIR SINK DRAINS. ANYONE FOUND DISCHARGING WATER ON THE GROUNDS WILL BE REMOVED BY ORDER OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT, AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO A FINE.
 9. IF, BECAUSE OF CIVIL DISTURBANCE OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE CLUB, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR COMPLETE THE SHOW, THERE IS NO REFUND OF ENTRY.
 10. DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES ON THE SHOW GROUNDS with the exception of the Obedience ring.
- ALL EXHIBITORS, HANDLERS AND PATRONS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW AND ABIDE BY THE CKC DOG SHOW RULES**
