

SCRATCHES: Approved scratches will forfeit \$10.00 per entry. Entry fees will be refunded for bitches in season or for injured dogs, upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate.

All qualifying dogs will receive a rosette

Ducks, pheasants and/or pigeons may be used in all stakes.

Release & Indemnification of Landowners: By entering this trial, each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the trial and agrees to release, save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) of any property upon which the trial is held together with their officers, agents, employees and representative from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participants' use or entry upon the property.

It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participant, or their heirs.

No judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under CKC rules, will be subjected to indignities of any kind. The Hunt Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
