Note: Awards of Merit will be made (if warranted) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed. **Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs** will be offered for sexually altered dogs over six months of age and will be judged after the judging of Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Baby Puppy Class - Dogs 3 months of and under 6 months on the day of the show. Both male and female Baby Puppies will be judged prior to the judging of other official classes. Puppies in this category may not compete in any official, unofficial or non regular class.

Brace Class – shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her progeny only

Note: All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

The official CKC classes, divided by sex, will be provided. Enter one category only.

Junior puppy	a dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show.
Senior puppy	a dog between 9 months up to 12 months on the day of show
12-18 months	a dog between 12 months up to 18months on the day of show
Canadian bred	a dog which was born in Canada.
Bred by exhibitor	a dog owned and handled by the breeder
Field Trial	a dog who has actually competed in the field trial
Open class	all dogs
Veterans	all dogs 7 years of age or older. Dogs may be neutered.
Specials only	dogs who are Canadian champions only
Exhibition	dogs 6 months and over, not in competition
Altered	dogs 6 months & over that have been sexually altered

A Bitch in season may not compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. Entry fees will be refunded ONLY if the Trial Secretary BEFORE commencement of the trial receives a Veterinarian's Certificate

Saturday, Oct 6 All dogs must be entered in one of the Official Classes or Exhibition Only at the English Springer Spaniel Club of Canada Specialty. Entry to be made at the show. Complete rules will appear in the Show Catalogue. A prize and rosette will be awarded for Best Overall Junior Handler and for 1st in each class.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age.

To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials or Exhibition Only..

There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class	for Dogs at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.
Senior Class	for Dogs at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.
12-18 Open	for Dogs at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps. A suitable prize will also be offered to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite in Sweeps.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up.

To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only.

There will be four classes in all, divided by sex.

7-9 years	for Dogs at least 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years
9-11 years	for Dogs 9 years of age up to but not including 11 years.
11 years +	for Dogs 11 years of age and older

The winners of all four classes will compete for Best Veteran in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps. A suitable prize will also be offered to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite in Sweeps. .

For both Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for best in

Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

50% of the entry fees for each sweeps class will go to the winner of each class;

15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps;

10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps

25% will be retained for administrative purposes.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS - CHAPTER 21

SECTION 1 - A dog awarded Winners at a championship show held under these Dogs Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder:

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Building will open at 7:00am on Saturday & Sunday. On Friday, the Building will be open from **4:00pm until 8:00pm for anyone wishing to set up early.**
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of shows, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- **All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.**
- Dogs should be in the building 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging and may be removed from the building after their breed. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The ESSCC and CDC will not be held responsible for any equipment left in the building overnight.
- A canteen will be available in the arena.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is enforced. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 6.3.3)
- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 6.3.4)
- The ESSCC and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the KCC and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.
- "Puppy for Sale" or "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.
- The precincts of the show shall be the entire building and its entrances.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

Introduction to scent work
The Sport of Scent Detection

Sporting Detection is the fun and competitive version of scent detection such as for narcotics, termites or explosives, and is also known as "nosework". **Sporting Detection Dogs Association**, (SDDA) competitions use legal scents that are easily purchased and stored by the average person. The dog must locate any and all hidden target scents within a designated area and alert the handler to the location. It is a true partnership sport in which both ends of the leash must rely on one another.
