Courses and Birds: All courses will be single course. Both senior stakes may have bird fields. Released birds will be Chukar, Quail or Pheasant. Other game birds may be present. No birds will be released in the Open Puppy stake. In the event of adverse course conditions, the Field Trial Chairman may adjust the courses (including adding or deleting bird field), and start times to suit.

Location: The Club is grateful to have the use of these grounds owned by Jim & Sue Deyell. A map showing the location of the grounds will be provided to entrants at the time the running order is distributed. We ask for your co-operation in keeping the grounds free of litter by using the garbage bags provided. Parking will be restricted to the marked areas and limited if grounds are wet. No smoking will be allowed on the trial grounds. Smoking is only permitted in your parked vehicles or RV.

General Information:

- Running and Handling: All stakes will be walking. There will be no horseback handling and no horseback gallery.
- Blank pistols only will be fired over all dogs with bird work. No live ammunition will be allowed in any stake.
- Total entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in the available daylight hours.
- All senior stakes will be 30 minutes in length. If there is a large entry, the Derby stake may be shortened to 20 minutes and the Puppy to 15 minutes.
- Collaring a dog away after game contact will be allowed.
- Bitches in season **will not** be permitted to run.
- Backing tests: If a dog has placed in one of the senior stakes of the Trial and needs only a backing test to complete the requirements for a Championship, the owner may request a backing test. This test will be allowed at the discretion of the Field Trial Chairman and will depend on the availability of birds. The test will cost \$25.00.

- Tracking Collars: The BSCC is allowing the use of electronic tracking collars in this trial. Only tracking collars that meet the CKC guidelines will be allowed. Participants must declare that they are using the tracking collars to the Field Trial chairman and also to the judges. NOTE: as per rule 11.4.10 With the exception of tracking collars, collars to be worn in competitive stakes must be a type solely used for purposes of identification. That is, the normal dog collar with name plate attached or coloured collars used to distinguish between dogs in a brace.
- **Placements will occur after each stake; this will allow participants to depart the grounds as quickly as possible after running their dog**

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind.

IMPORTANT CHANGE: TCN Number: (Previously Listing fees) A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) has been established by The Canadian Kennel Club and MUST ACCOMPANY the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. This fee is \$10.50 (incl GST) per dog per each event entered during the field test and is in addition to the entry fee(s). Exhibitors should be aware that the CKC does not confer a title on any dog until it is registered individually in their records. Please visit www.CKC.ca to obtain your TCN

Reminder: There will be no exercising or training of any dogs on the grounds before, during, or after the Trial without the permission of the Field Trial Chairman or the Field Trial Secretary. All participants must be familiar with the CKC Rules and also the rules & provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Trial rulebooks are available from the CKC or they are on-line at the CKC website for CKC members.

Accommodations: Camping will be allowed on the grounds on Friday and Saturday nights and will be restricted to marked areas. Facilities are limited so please come prepared; *no hospitality available*. An outhouse will be provided. Cochrane motels: Bow River Inn – (403) 932-7900; Cochrane Super 8 – (403) 932-6355.

Please note: ALL PERSONS WHO ENTER THE GROUNDS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SIGN A WAIVER PRIOR TO ENTERING OR ENGAGING IN ANY ACTIVITIES ON THE GROUNDS. This is the requirement of the landowner. We need to have as many waivers as we can prior to the trial.

Prizes: Standard CKC rosettes will be awarded to the placing dogs in all stakes.

COVID 19

Due to the Covid 19 Pandemic the club will be adhering to all recommended guidelines in the Province of Alberta. Since this is an outdoor event masks will not be mandatory but please respect the physical distancing guidelines and other people's space. We highly recommend showing up running your dog and leaving.

General guidelines to consider:

1. Practice physical distancing consistent with guidelines in effect at the time of the event. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
2. Consider wearing masks when in close proximity to others. The Club will provide masks if desired for officials, judges and volunteers
3. Wash hands as frequently as possible. We will have disinfecting spray and or wipes at bathroom facilities for people to spray door handles (or anything else they touch).
4. Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact.
5. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.

Things to remember:

2. Bring water and food for yourself and your dogs.
3. The Club is grateful to have the use of these grounds. We ask for your co-operation in keeping the grounds free of litter by using the garbage bags provided. Parking will be restricted to the marked areas and limited if grounds are wet. No smoking will be allowed on the trial grounds. Smoking is only permitted in your parked vehicle.
4. If your dog poops, please scoop and dispose in the provided garbage bags or consider packing out your own refuge.
