Junior Handling, Saturday May 14th, 2011

Junior Handling competition will be held during lunch break. Pee Wee class (unofficial) will be offered. All dogs handed in this competition must be entered in one of the official classes or for exhibition on Saturday May 14th. Judges will be announced at the show.

JUNIOR HANDLING PROVINCIAL FINALS

The MHCA is pleased to also welcome the Alberta Junior Handling Provincial Finals - This event is by invitation only and will feature Alberta's top 25 competitors in both Conformation & Obedience from 2010. Event to be held approximately one hour after Best in Show judging on Saturday evening May 14th, 2011. Judges TBA. Classes

Junior Puppy Class. Dogs 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on day of show. Senior Puppy Class. Dogs 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on day of show. 12 to 18 Month Class.

Canadian Bred Class. Dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded. Bred by Exhibitor Class. Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

Open Class. All dogs may be divided by colour if permission of the CKC is obtained. Veterans Class (specialty shows only).

Specials Only. Dogs which have a recorded CKC registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Vet or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee, or entered incorrectly.
2. If because of riot, civil disturbance or acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, there will be no refund of entries.
3. Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in Obedience comes into season as per CKC Obedience rules.
4. Judging will not commence before 9:00 am on Friday May 13th.
5. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the Show.
6. Dogs shall be exercised only in specified areas provided by the Club.
7. The Club will use due care & diligence for the welfare of dogs & exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons or property.

*** NOTICE TO NON CKC MEMBER PARTICIPANTS ***

Effective January 1st, 2011 an annual non member participation fee for all awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee \$55.00. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the Non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. This fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non CKC members and not dogs co-owned by a CKC member.

Champions and Championship Points

A dog awarded winners at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded winners shall be provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded winners shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more	
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*includes the dog awarded winners.

The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded winners shall be determined by the highest award (Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex and/or Best of Breed) earned and calculated as per section. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.
