Dog ID cards must be shown at check-in if your dog has not trialed at a L2P event before, or since 2018 with the new jump heights.

Then turn right onto Morraine Rd, then part way up the hill, turn left onto Upper Glade Rd. Glade Acres (Dan and Glenda Harris) is on the right at 2242 Upper Glade Road).

## **CRATING AND SET-UP**

The site will be available for set up after 12 noon on Wednesday. Lost or damaged personal property is not the responsibility of Love 2 Play or the site management. Valuables should not be left in your vehicle.

## **NOTICE TO COMPETITORS**

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable AAC rules and regulations including, but not limited to, the following rules regarding entry:

- **Bitches in season are permitted to** compete in this trial. Details are at the end of the premium.
- **All dogs must be registered with AAC to compete in the agility trial.** It is your responsibility to provide the Trial Secretary with your dog's AAC number prior to the closing date or your entry will be rejected.
- **Safety** shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. Handlers, through entry at this event, accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.
- **Obstacles and stations** shall be chosen from those described in the rules and regulations of the AAC and shall conform to this organization's specifications.
- **Collars:** At the handler's option, dogs are allowed to wear a simple flat buckle or quick release collar on course. Collars cannot be loose fitting, and nothing can be attached to the collar such as dangling tags or tabs. There can be no decorations or enhancements that project from the face of the collar except for the leash attachment. A flat name plate or embroidery name would be accepted. Any dog wearing an improper collar or any other item while competing must be eliminated. Furthermore, the dog may not be permitted to continue the run while wearing an improper collar or other item.
- It is expressly understood that competitors alone are responsible for the behaviour of their dogs and/or children. Any competitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behaviour may be asked to leave. NO REFUND of fees will be paid.
- All dogs must be penned, crated or on leash when not in the ring. **All dogs must be under control when they leave the ring after their run.** Any dog engaging in aggressive or out of control behavior when leaving the ring will be disqualified and/or required to leave the trial site. NO REFUND of fees will be paid.
- Exhibitors must keep crate and exercise areas clean. Please pick up after yourself and your dogs. We need to keep this great venue available for future dog events!
- There will be no refund after the closing date for dogs that are withdrawn, with the exception of bitches in season or sick/injured dogs if the Trial Secretary is notified prior to the trial date and provided with a vet's certificate.
- Trial organizers reserve the right to refuse any entry and if an exhibitor must be asked to leave the show grounds for any reason, they will not be issued a refund.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry by AAC and Love 2 Play Dog Training (aka Love 2 Play Dog Sports) (the “Organizing Club”) and the opportunity to have the Dog participate, compete in and/or be judged at this event or trial (the “Event”), I, the undersigned, agree as follows:

1. I certify that I am the actual owner of the Dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner of the Dog and that the Dog is not a hazard to persons, property or other dogs.
2. I agree that AAC or the Organizing Club for the Event may refuse my entry for any reason that it deems to be sufficient.
3. I understand and acknowledge that participation in the Event carries certain risks, including, but not limited to injuries (including serious injuries and death) to myself, the Dog, another dog under my control or persons attending as my guests (my “**Related Parties**”), damage to property and other losses. I waive any and all claims that I have or may have in the future against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue AAC, the Organizing Club or any of the directors, executives, committees, representatives, employees, volunteers or agents of either AAC or the Organizing Club (the “**Personnel**”) for any injury, death, property damage or other loss that I or my Related Parties sustain due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence, breach of contract, breach of duty, statutory or otherwise, or mistakes or errors of judgment of any kind.
4. I assume full responsibility for the conduct of myself and my Related Parties during the entirety of the Event. I agree to indemnify and save harmless AAC, the Organizing Club and the Personnel from and against any and all claims that may be made against them or costs, fees, expenses or liability (including, without limitation, lawyers’ fees on a solicitor and own client basis) incurred by AAC, the Organizing Club or the Personnel that may arise due to:
  - (a) any act or omission of myself, my Related Parties or any party for whom I am liable at law; or
  - (b) aggressive behaviour by the Dog or any other dog under my control.
5. I have read, and do understand the rules of competition and the additional rules (if any) appearing in the trial schedule for the Event, as well as the policies of AAC pertaining to discipline (collectively, the “**Rules**”). I agree to abide by the Rules and to conduct myself and the Dog in accordance with the Rules. I understand that myself and/or the Dog may be subject to disciplinary procedures or sanctions for breach of the Rules and agree to respect and be bound by any disciplinary decision made by AAC.
6. I understand that AAC and/or the Organizing Club may, in the course of administering the Event or conducting its activities generally, collect, use or disclose my personal information and that any personal information collected, used or disclosed by AAC and/or the Organizing Club will be treated in accordance with AAC policy and applicable privacy and personal information laws. ## **BITCHES IN SEASON POLICY**

As per AAC Rulebook Update v. 8.7 (July 1, 2022), Love2Play is allowing bitches in season (BIS) to attend the trial site and to compete in this AAC sanctioned trial, using the following procedures:

- Handlers are required to notify the trial secretary of a BIS at the trial as soon as it is known
- Handlers of BIS must minimize exposure of their BIS to other dogs and limit their movements on the trial grounds
- The handler of the BIS or the handler of any other dog may withdraw from the trial with a full refund if they choose not to compete because of the BIS
- Competitors will be notified that there will be BIS on site
- A protective mat shall be used at the start line. The handler is responsible for supplying their own mat in good repair and, cleaning it appropriately
- BIS will run as a group at the end of each class
- "BIS" will be noted next to the dog's name on the gate sheet so that other competitors, ring crew and Judges are aware
- BIS will be crated at or in their vehicle, isolated from other crating areas
- BIS must use a designated walking and relief area
- BIS must wear well-fitted protective panties, specifically designed for the purpose of containing seasonal discharges. Panties may only be removed when running, when in the designated relief area, or when crated.
