Directions:

From Toronto Area: QEW to Hamilton take the 403 Hamilton Exit 74 for HWY 6 North to Guelph. Turn left onto HWY 5 Christie Lake Conservation is 9 km down on the left hand side.

From Hamilton: 403 East Exit 74 for HWY 6 North Guelph. Turn Left onto HWY 5. Christie lake is 9 km down on the left hand side.

From London Area: 401 East towards Toronto. Take 403 Hamilton Exit 74 for HWY 6 North to Guelph. Turn left onto hwy 5 Christie Lake is 9km down hwy on the left hand side. Or you can stay on the 401 and the hwy 6 south exit. Drive down HWY 6 to Hwy 5 (Clappison Corners) and turn right and follow down road 9km to Conservation area
