TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER: \$11.50 - A TCN fee as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration (ERN) is not shown on the entry form.”

These tests are open to mixed breeds and unrecognized breeds as per section 2.2.4.

Fees are due in Canadian funds.

Entry Draw: All entries received prior to the closing date will be acknowledged by email that the entry was received. A random draw of all non-duplicate entries will be conducted on Thursday September 19th at 7:15pm, at the Bill McGuire Centre, Rothesay, NB, or via virtual meeting at that same time, open to any interested parties, if KOC is not holding classes at that time. After all the tracks have been filled the draw will continue to create a list of alternates. Acceptance letters will be sent out within 24 hours of the draw. Entries will be refunded within ten days of the tracking test to those on the alternate list who did not participate in the test.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Effective January 1, 2011, the Canadian Kennel Club has implemented a non-member participation fee which will be charged to a resident of Canada who is not a member of the Canadian Kennel Club. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by the non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

DIRECTIONS TO TEST SITE

From Fredericton: Take Exit 365 (Sussex, Fundy), travel approx. 29km on Route 10, then turn left onto Mount Middleton Road, the farm is located on the right.

From Moncton or Saint John: Take Exit 193 and continue straight at the stop sign onto Route 10 towards Fredericton. Mount Middleton Road will be on your right approximately 6km from the exit. The farm will be on your right.

Track draw site : 56 Mount Middleton Road

This is a working farm, please keep all dogs on leash at all times.

The Kennebecasis Obedience Club will use all reasonable care to guarantee the safety of dogs and persons at the tests, however, neither will accept the responsibility for loss or injury, however caused, to any dog, person or property.

Ch. 14.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Tracking Test Committee Chair shall promptly

report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
