No post-dated cheques will be accepted.

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering dogs. Receipt of entries and judging schedule will be mailed as soon as possible after the closing date.

Receipt of entries will be E-mailed when an address is provided.

NSF cheques are subject to a \$30.00 charge. A CKC listing fee of \$11.30 per dog is payable with the entry fee if the form for the dog does not include it's CKC individual registration number.

Any dog not on hand after the third call will be marked absent.

The German Shepherd Dog Club of Canada, Inc. will use all reasonable care to guarantee the safety of dogs exhibited, but will not be responsible for loss or injury to a dog, exhibitor, or spectator. The Festival Inn will not be liable for any personal injuries which may occur to any participant or spectator of the show.

The Show Superintendent will have entire charge and control of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities in accordance with CKC Dog Show Rules, Section 19.7. All dogs must be kept on leash at all time and under control. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. The Show Precincts shall consist of all areas set out for rings and an area of 10 feet outside of the judging

Event Registration Number (ERN)

Effective Jan. 1/92, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN number *MUST* be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

for any dog which has earned the title of CDX or UD.

PRE-NOVICE CLASS

For any dog which has not earned the title of PCD.

For any dog which has earned the title of CD, CDX, UD or OTCH.

NOVICE C

For dogs which have earned the title of Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog, and any other advanced Obedience title in Canada.

NOT ELIGIBLE FOR HIGH IN TRIAL

In Novice A and Open A one dog only may be entered in the classes by any one exhibitor, and every dog must be exhibited by the owner or a member of his immediate family. No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who previously exhibited the dog through its U.D. title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete as an exhibitor. If any exhibitor enters more than one dog in Novice B or Open B classes, each dog must have a separate handler for the sit and down exercises.
