The VIPDC will conduct an approved Field Dog Test for all pointing breeds on April 4th, 2014 at Springford Farm, 1884 Northwest Bay Road, Nanoose, BC Nanoose Bay, BC. The Test is held under the pointing breeds Field Trial and Field Dog Test Rules and Regulations, effective January 1, 2014, of the Canadian Kennel Club, Suite 400-200 Robson Drive, Etobicoke, Ontario, M9W 5Z9

Courses and Birds: All courses will be a single designated route. Chukar, Pheasant, Quail or alternate game birds will be released throughout the course for all tests. In the advent of adverse course conditions the Field Test Chairman may adjust the course.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All stakes are walking stakes. Horses are neither required by handlers nor allowed. Blank pistols, .22 cal minimum will be fired over all dogs with bird work. No live ammunition will be allowed in any stake. Pistols must have solid barrels
- Total entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in the available daylight hours
- The Club reserves the right to rearrange the running order of the stakes should conditions warrant.
- Collaring a dog away after game contact will be allowed.
- Bitches in season will be permitted to run, at the end of the given stake.
Entrants must notify event secretary prior to start of said stake, or run will be forfeited.
- Backing Tests: If a dog has placed in one of the senior stakes of the Test and needs only a backing test to complete the requirements for a Championship, the owner may request a backing test. This test will be allowed at the discretion of the Field Test Chairman and will depend on the availability of birds. The test will cost \$20.00
- Tracking Collars: Approved electronic collars may be used. Any questions regarding their use should be referred to the Field Test Chairman
- All participants must be familiar with the CKC Rules and also the rules and provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Test rulebooks are available from the CKC or on-line at the CKC website for CKC members.
- **It shall be the duty and obligation of the Test-giving Club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or competitor at a Field Test is not subject to indignities. The Field Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.**

PRIZES: Standard CKC rosettes and plaques will be awarded to the placing dogs in all Field tests, as appropriate.

Entries will close at 3:00 p.m. on March 30th 2014, and the draw will be held at the above address.

ENTRY FEES are to be paid in Canadian funds by credit card, cash, cheque or money order payable to the Vancouver Island Pointing Dog Club. The Field Test Secretary will acknowledge the receipt of electronically transmitted entries. All entry forms are to be completed and in the hands of the Field Test Secretary and entry fees paid in

full prior to the running of the dog. An additional \$5.00 fee will be assessed on credit card entries.

LISTING FEE: A listing fee as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN), Performance Event Number (PEN) or Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) is not shown on the entry form. This listing fee is per dog per each event entered during the Field Test and is in addition to the entry fee(s).

All entries are accepted on the condition that the Vancouver Island Pointing Dog Club, its officers, directors, membership and landowners assume no responsibility for participants or spectators in the event of injury or damage to persons, animals, or properties in conjunction with or during the running of the Field Test. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of the parent or guardian.

BORDER CROSSING: A rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into or out of Canada and the rabies certificate must be dated at least 30 days prior to crossing the border.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011 Non-member participation fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

Field Test Location: Springford Farm, 1884 Northwest Bay Road, Nanoose Bay, BC. Northwest Bay Road is located approximately 24 km North of Nanaimo on the Island Highway (#19). Access to Nanaimo on Vancouver Island is provided by BC Ferries from either Horseshoe Bay Terminal to Departure Bay just north of Nanaimo or Tsawwassen to Duke Point just south of Nanaimo. Please check with BC Ferries website at www.bcferries.com for official times and fares. Their website is very user friendly. Once you are off the ferry you will take Highway 19 North past Nanaimo until you reach Nanoose Bay, turn right at the light at the Petrocan Station (you are now on Northwest Bay Road). Continue approximately 5 kms until you see the pointing dog signs. Please follow the pointing dog signs to the west edge of the property and refrain from using the main drive to house or barns.
