GENERAL INFORMATION – MUST READ

- **Rules:** Hunt Test Rules and Regulations Books are available from the Canadian Kennel Club, 100 – 89 Skyway Ave., Etobicoke, ON M9W 6R4
- **Listing Fee:** if you do not have a CKC Registration, ERN or PEN number- A \$9.40 (including PST/GST) listing fee as established by the CKC must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration, Event Registration Number (ERN) or Performance Event Number (PEN) is not shown on the entry form.
- **Canadian Resident Non-CKC Member:** If you are a Canadian resident and not a CKC member please read the [CKC Non-Member Participation Fee](#) policy (effective January, 1st, 2011)
- **Entries:** Entries must be typewritten or CLEARLY printed, completely filled out and signed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms or where hand-writing is not clearly legible. No phone, faxed, emailed, late or day of entries will be accepted. A separate entry for EACH dog in EACH test is required on an official CKC entry form. ERN's (Event Registration Numbers) for foreign born or foreign owned dogs can be obtained from the CKC or Hunt Test Headquarters. ERN must be applied for within 30 days of entering a CKC event.
- **Awards:** Official CKC Rosettes and duck bands will be awarded to all qualifying dogs at the end of the test day.
- **Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded after June 27th, 2014. In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee or the Canadian Kennel Club, no refund of entry will be made. Bitches in season are NOT eligible for entry and are not allowed on the test grounds. Bitches may be subject to vetting. Entry and listing fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of estrus, illness or death shall be refunded in full if notification in writing is accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate. All refunds must be requested in writing and once the catalogue has been printed, will be less CKC event fees and listing fees if applicable.
- **Running Order:** Running order will be drawn at the home of the Test Secretary. Males and females will be run in the order of the draw or at the discretion of the Marshall.
- **Start Times:** Start times will be adhered to as strictly as possible and handlers are asked to be at their stake and checked in with their Marshall a minimum of 15 minutes prior to start time regardless of running order.
- **Clothing:** All handlers and spectators shall wear hunting attire, dark or camouflage clothing.
- **Birds:** Dead ducks, pheasants and/or chukkar partridge may be used in each stake. Live pheasants, pigeons or chukkar partridge may be used in the flushing test at the Master stake.
- **Grounds:** CKC Hunt Test Rule Section 2.5.1 – “There shall be no training of dogs on the grounds of a hunt test, except for single training bumpers which are thrown by hand by the handler, either within 24 hours of the commencement of the event, or at any time during the event. The Hunt Test Committee is responsible for enforcement of this provision.” All dogs when not running in their test MUST be on leash and under control. Bring adequate shade, sunscreen, water and cover for hot or rainy weather for both you and your dog(s). Be prepared and carry a first aid kit. YOU MUST pick up after your dog and airing is only allowed in areas designated by Hunt Test Headquarters and Test Marshalls. Please respect the landowners that have so graciously allowed us on their land by obeying all signs, removing all garbage and debris. Close all gates behind you and park ONLY in designated areas.
- **Collars:** CKC Hunt Test Rule Section 2.5.2 – “Electronic collars (either dummy or live) as well as prong or pinch type collars shall not be worn by a dog on the grounds, of a Hunt Test at any time during the event with the exception of those collars designed to curb barking which may be worn by a dog while kenneled.
- **Concession:** There will be a BBQ hot lunch concession (Farmers sausage on a bun) at Hunt Test Headquarters on Sunday July 6th, 2014 ONLY. Fresh baked cinnamon buns and Tim Horton's coffee will be available to purchase at Hunt Test Headquarters from 7:30am – 9:00am daily while quantities last.
- **Indignities to Judges:** CKC Hunt Test Rule Section 20.7 – “It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. On report of the test-giving Club of an alleged indignity of any kind, the Hunt Test Committee of the Club shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall at once render its decision to the parties concerned. It shall also, within twenty-one days after the test, report to the Canadian Kennel Club the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and its findings. The Discipline Committee of The Canadian Kennel Club shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated. A copy of this rule shall be prominently placed in every premium list.” BY ATTENDING this test, competitors and spectators acknowledge that the Upper Island Retriever Club, test officials and the Landowners involved do not accept liability for any loss, damage or injury incurred by exhibitors, dogs or spectators.
- **CNMRC:** The UIRC is a member in good standing with the Canadian National Master Retriever Club. As of July 1, 2010 only passes at Hunt Tests hosted by clubs in good standing of the CNMRC are considered in determining eligibility to enter the National Master Hunt Test Stake.
- **ALL Competitors & Spectators:** If you have any questions or concerns, need more information please contact the Test Secretary. By attending this test, competitors and spectators acknowledge that the Upper Island Retriever Club, test officials, volunteers and landowners DO NOT ACCEPT liability for any loss, damage or injury incurred by competitors, exhibitors, dogs or spectators.

HUNT TEST HEADQUARTERS & CHECK IN TIME(see map below for directions)

- **Check in:** When you first arrive (your first test day) please check in at Hunt Test Headquarters at least 30 -45 minutes before your test start time to receive your catalogue, maps and instructions to test locations. Test days following you may check in with your Marshall(s) at your test location(s) a minimum of 15 minutes before your start time.
- **Hunt Test Headquarters:** will be located at Swamp Dog Farm, 7531 Albert Rd., Black Creek BC. We ask everyone to drive SLOW on the roads leading to Hunt Test Headquarters and Test locations. This is a farming community, watch for children, farm machinery, animals, farm dogs – be aware and obey ALL posted speed limits. Allow ample time to travel between test locations and always advise your Marshall that you are leaving when running multiple test stakes.

Follow Albert Rd to Swamp Dog Farm

From **Hwy 19a** (Island Highway)
Turn on **Kelland Rd**
(**RIGHT** turn if coming from North, **LEFT** if coming from South)
Follow **Kelland Rd** for approx 1.2 km
Turn **LEFT** on **Albert Rd.**
