If it has not the show will be cancelled and 80% of your entry fee will be refunded.

In addition we must be vigilant in observing provincial and regional guidelines regarding travel into and out of zones which are designated "ORANGE". At all times we must ensure that we are doing everything possible to keep our friends and communities safe. Every person entering the property will be screened and will be refused entry if you are violating any provincial guideline regarding travel. If you are in doubt, check with the province. Anyone who has travelled outside the Atlantic Bubble is required to self-Isolate for 14 days upon returning to Atlantic Canada before travelling within the bubble.

We respectfully request that if you cannot or will not comply with these guidelines, Do Not Enter or Attend! THERE WILL BE A ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY ON COVID-19 VIOLATIONS, INCLUDING NOT WEARING A MASK OR NOT SOCIAL DISTANCING WHEN REQUIRED.

Our Waiver must be signed by Club Members, Judges, Ring Stewards, Exhibitors, Owners, Handlers, Breeders, Assistants, Volunteers, Vendors, Family Members, Friends Etc. Contact tracing information must be provided for all who attend (name & phone number). Everyone must wear masks correctly over mouth and nose: Exhibitors, Judges, Stewards in the rings during judging. A 120 X 120' perimeter will be fenced around the show pavilion and rings, and masks will be required while in this space. They will also be required anywhere on the property where social distancing (2 meters) cannot be maintained (e.g. Vender Area, in Washrooms) Social distancing (2 meters) is Mandatory in the rings, under the tents, adjacent ring areas, at the Show Secretary Table/Set-up, at the Photographers booth

Each ring will have an Entrance, an Exit and Social Distancing Markers. Exhibitors will pick up their placement ribbons as they exit the ring. NO RECYCLING of ribbons. If you do not want your ribbons, Please leave them on the table.

Exhibitors are encouraged to return to their set ups after they have exhibited their dog. SHOW & GO.

Parking will be directed and space is not an issue. You may request as much space as required for your set-up. Generators are permitted in the parking area, as are personal ex-pens, grooming tables, pop-up tents, portable picnic tables etc.

# ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The show is NOT OPEN to the General Public

Show Site Access Process: The waiver will be emailed along with the judging schedule. You will be required to print off enough waivers so that every individual traveling with you has their own waiver. The Waiver(s) will be handed into the club upon arrival at the show site, attendance wrist band will be provided at this time only. It is recommended that each group provides a cell phone contact number upon entering that will be in use during the show. The Club will provide hand sanitizing stations. Grooming tables used in the ring will be cleaned frequently. No indoor grooming area and power is not supplied. No grooming tables, crates or trolleys under the pavilion. No chairs under the pavilion. No public ex-pens. Be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, Bring personal use masks. Do not leave personal belongings at ringside. Do not leave masks, gloves, water bottles, litter, etc behind. Dispose of these items in the garbage bins. Aviod shaking hands, hugging or other physical contact.

Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility, Avoid common use pens/pencils – bring your own writing instrument.

If you observe activity which causes you concern, please report it immediately to our Show Superintendent. We want to maintain a non-confrontational environment in all aspects of our event, which at times is difficult when dealing with this very polarizing issue. We take this very seriously and want to ensure the safety of everyone attending our shows as well as the people in their communities to which they will be returning. We also recognize our responsibility to the dog show community to avoid any perceived or actual violations to the public health protocols put in place by our Provincial Government.

## Official CKC Entry Forms MUST be used.

All entries are to be sent to the Show Sec't and must be received on or before the closing date & time. **PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE YOUR ENTRIES**. Remember your entry can only be as accurate as the information you provide. The Show Secretary is **NOT RESPONSIBLE** for incorrect information provided by the entrant. Please read your entry carefully before you submit it. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the errors were made. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Rules.

Photocopy extra Entry Forms if required. If a dog is entered in more than one class or event a separate entry form is required for each one.

NO POST DATED CHEQUES ACCEPTED. ALL NSF cheques are subject to a charge of \$25.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered Non-Payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. ALL FEES MUST BE PAID BEFORE THE SHOWS.

# EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

- Send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership, for example, AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN.
- 2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
- 3. Ensure that you provide the CKC with your full return address to enable the ERN to be sent to you.
- 4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA/MasterCard number and expiry date, the card holders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number **MUST** be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED"; however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores. # TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (\* EFFECTIVE MARCH 2, 2020)

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN).

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

Dogs may still enter CKC events until without a registration number or ERN until March 2, 2020 by marking TCN on the entry form (or Listed if it is an older entry form). An email address is required on the entry form in this case. Before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will

be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account.

\* If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. The CKC will update its records accordingly.

**INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED.** Agents and handlers please note that the **full name and address of owners MUST be filled in** and to whom ID's are to be returned. (Section 13.1.2 Dog Show Rules)

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show. **NOTE: In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall <u>NOT</u> be included in the calculation for Championship points.** 

## NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian

"non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number. In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled.

Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US Funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not make cheques "Payable In Canadian Funds", they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

#### **RULES & RULE BOOKS**

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or participant at any event held under CKC Rules, is not subjected to indignities of any kind. The Show Committee shall promptly report any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of report, indicating that this has occurred.

No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing to favour his/her entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this Rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act (Section 4.1.6 Dog Show rules)

No person shall enter or exhibit a dog under a judge where that judge has owned, conditioned, sold, handled, held under lease or boarded within 6 months prior to the date of the show at which he/she officiates as a Judge. This rule shall apply regardless of whether the judge benefited in any way from any of the aforementioned activities. (Section 4.1.7 dog Show rules).

A copy of the Rules pertaining Dog Shows and/or Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club 1-416-675-5511. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to know the rules pertaining to these events.

The Show Superintendent will be in complete charge of these events, which are governed by CKC rules.

All Judging will commence at 9:00 a.m. unless entries warrant an earlier or later start time. Group Judging will commence on completion of Breed Judging within each Group. **PROVIDING TIME ALLOWS,** a break at the end of each group will allow for photographs to be taken. No two groups will be judged at the same time.

"Double Handling" will not be tolerated. The Superintendent reserves the right to request those exhibitors doing so to leave the site. The Oromocto Kennel Club will use all due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators
