**Entry Fees (Cdn or U.S.): TD test: \$85.00; TDX test: \$100.00**

- A TCN (Temporary Competition) fee of \$11.30 Cdn or U.S. must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration number, or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. **ELIGIBILITY:**

- There is no prerequisite for a CKC TD test.
- A CKC TD title is a prerequisite for entering a CKC TDX test.
- A dog eligible for a PEN number must have their PEN number prior to entering, and may not enter as a Listed dog.
- Canadian entrants who are not CKC Members: An annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles will be charged for dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member. This fee is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned by CKC members. Non-CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee within 30 days of notification, or awards will be cancelled by the CKC.

*Entry is limited by club and site resources.*

**AWARDS:** Each passing team will be awarded a Rosette and Medallion from TBK&TC.

## Field Tracking Tests: June 25 & 26, 2022: General Information

**Note:** We are also running Urban Tests this weekend (see separate Premium & Entry form). On SATURDAY, FIELD entries have priority, and Sunday is Urban priority. So we recommend you send your Field entry for Saturday. If you wish to send a second Field entry for Sunday, we may accept some Field entries on Sunday IF Urban has not filled, exchanging tracks in accordance with CKC tracking rules 6.2.2, and subject to club and site resources.

### ENTRY & PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS:

- Make cheques payable to "THUNDER BAY KENNEL & TRAINING CLUB".
- Each entry must be in a separate envelope, addressed to the Test Secretary, with payment.
- Entries may be mailed, couriered or hand-delivered to the Secretary, or put in the Drop Box.
- U.S. Exhibitors: We accept U.S. cheques or U.S. bank Money orders in U.S. funds. Please do not mark U.S. cheques as "Payable in Canadian funds" as the bank will not accept them.
- An NSF cheque will be subject to a \$40.00 service charge. The Entry Fee plus NSF fee must be paid in cash prior to competing.
- We do not accept faxed or emailed entries, or electronic payment.

### ENTRY DRAW, ALTERNATE LIST, and REFUNDS:

- Entrants will be notified by email or phone when the entry has been received by the Test Secretary.
- An Entry Draw will be held at the Secretary's address on Thursday June 16<sup>th</sup> (the day after Closing) at 6:30pm. Exhibitors will be notified by email within 24 hours, of their placement in each test or on the Alternate List.
- A Club Worker Draw (per CKC 6.6.2) may be utilized if enough entries are in a class and if eligible entries are received from Club Workers as defined by the TBK&TC Tracking committee.
- An entry of a non-titled dog in a given class (level) will be given preference over the entry of a dog already having the CKC title in that class/level. (CKC rule 6.1.18). Purebred dogs - untitled or titled - have preference over entries of Mixed Breed or Unrecognized breeds.
- If an entered dog is withdrawn after the Closing Date, a refund will be given if the vacancy is accepted by an Alternate. Alternates will be contacted in Catalogue order and may accept or decline. Remaining Alternates as of test day are encouraged to attend the Track Draw in case Absentee spaces become available.
- Cheques for entries not drawn will not be cashed and will be returned or destroyed at the exhibitor's option.

### MEETING PLACE & DRAW FOR TRACK ORDER:

The Draws will be held Outdoors at Tim Horton's at the corner of Oliver Road and Golf Links Rd

**Saturday June 25th: 8:30 am** Draw order for Saturday tracks: (Field and Urban)

**Sunday, June 26th: 9:00 am** Draw order for Sunday tracks: (Urban and Field)

- The Secretary will advise all Entrants of any changes to the above-noted times.
- Any primary entrant(s) who is absent at the assigned draw time will forfeit his/her position if there are alternates present. Please be sure to arrive on time for your draw.
- Bitches in season will be permitted to compete, but may be assigned the last track at the judge's discretion. Please advise the Test Secretary as soon as possible (at the latest being upon arrival at the meeting place for the Track Draw)
- COVID precautions: Although the government has lifted many restrictions concerning Covid, we ask that everyone respect the concerns and individual risk factors of others and keep us all safe. Masks are not necessary but welcomed, as is awareness of social distancing.
- Driving: We convoy from track to track, so please listen carefully for the instructions as we depart each site, keep up with the convoy, and watch for the parking directions on arrival at each site (we may want you in a different spot than the Judge & Tracklayer vehicles). Allow the next exhibitor to follow the Judge vehicle. If you need to leave the convoy, do it when we are not moving (or someone may inadvertently follow you!).

**DISCIPLINE:** RULE 14.7 The test-giving club has the duty and obligation to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Club shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation.
