Junior puppy	a dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show.
Senior puppy	a dog between 9 months up to 12 months on the day of show
12-15 Month	a dog between 12 months up to 18 months on the day of show
15-18 Month	a dog between 12 months up to 18 months on the day of show
Canadian bred	a dog which was born in Canada.
Bred by exhibitor	a dog owned and handled by the breeder
Open class	all dogs over 12 months of age"
Specials only	dogs who are Canadian champions only
Veterans	a dog 7 years and over
Altered Class	For sexually altered dogs
Baby Puppy	A dog 4 months up to 6 months on the day of the show
Exhibition	dogs 6 months and over, not in competition. Dogs 3 months of age

Exhibition dogs 6 months and over, not in competition. Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 puppies.

<u>Note</u>: Awards of Merit will be made (if warranted) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

GENERAL INFORMATION

THE PRECINCTS OF THE TRIAL WILL BE THE SHOW BUILDING AND ENTRANCE *parking lot & grounds as per the COVID Protocol).* The show premises will be opening one hour before start of the show. Judging schedule and identification will be emailed as soon as possible after the entry closing date. The Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club of Atlantic Canada will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors or patrons. Judging will not be delayed to accommodate an exhibitor or handler who fails to have his/her dog in the ring when required. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the trials Only dogs entered in the show are permitted within the show precincts please. If because of; an act of God, riot, civil disturbance, extreme weather event, governmental orders, regulations, or decree, or other acts or circumstances beyond the control of the CKCSCAC it is impossible to open or complete the Shows/Trials, no refund of entry fees will be made.

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. An INCOMPLETE ENTRY FORM WILL BE RETURNED. Please ensure that your postal code is included. ALL NSF CHEQUES WILL BE CHARGED A \$35.00 SERVICE CHARGE.

2. Exhibitors must abide by the errors made when making the entry, regardless how or who made the entry.

3. An entry will not be accepted unless accompanied by the required fees. Post-dated cheques will **not** be accepted.

4. The CKCSCAC reserves the right to reject any entry subject to CKC rules.

5. Only dogs, which are eligible for registration or are registered by the CKC, may be entered in these Show & Trials.

6. Overpayment of entry fees up to a maximum of \$5.00 will be considered a donation to CKCSCAC Trophy Fund.

7. The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Dog Show Rules of the CKC.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - Effective January 1, 2023

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). Listed Breeds that do not yet have a Miscellaneous Class Number (MCN) number will be eligible to apply for a TCN.

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN) from the Canadian Kennel Club. **Effective January 1, 2023**, the policy has been changed to allow Listed Breeds registered with a different Canadian registry to also apply for an ERN. Canadian Born dogs that are registrable by a breed association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada may obtain an ERN.

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership - with a written request for an ERN. Include full payment in the amount of \$62.40 plus tax. Accounts may be paid with a personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or MasterCard. For Non-Members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates. Provide us with your full return address. - Faxed requests will be accepted. Please include your VISA/MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30-day extension. A class dog awarded Best in Show at any All Breed Championship Show will be credited with Five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. Attention Foreign Exhibitors Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You.

All exhibitors will be responsible for the clean up of their own dogs or dogs they are handling anywhere on the show site and surrounding areas.
