ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. BRED BY EXHIBITOR AWARD

CKC definition for <u>BRED BY EXHIBITOR</u>: this class is for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/ breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards

Anyone entering this class will automatically be eligible to compete for the Bred by Exhibitor Award. Should you wish to compete and ARE NOT entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class, but entered into one of the other regular classes, it WILL BE YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to notify the ring steward before entering the ring at the breed level that you qualify to compete for this award. Judging for the Group winner will follow the judging of the Altered in Group judging and before Best in Show judging on Saturday, June 17, Shows # 3 and 4. It is the responsibility of the owner to NOTIFY THE RING STEWARD and to be at ringside in time for the judging of the Bred by Exhibitor in Group to commence should they wish to compete for this award.

JUNIOR HANDLING Sat, June 17 and Sun, June 18 during the lunch break.

All dogs handled must be entered in this competition must be entered in one of the official classes on the day of the event. Rosettes will be awarded for first placement in each class and the Best Junior Handler Overall, as designated by the CKC.

Pee Wee Class: This class is for handlers 4 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 7th birthday. This class is optional and non-competitive. No placements are to be awarded; only participant ribbons, rosettes and token trophies may be presented.

Junior Novice Class: This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have NOT won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

Junior Open Class: This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who HAVE won 6 first places with competition.

Intermediate Novice Class: This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have NOT won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

Intermediate Open Class: This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who HAVE won 6 first places with competition and for any handler who has progressed through the Junior Open level and feels he has enough experience to compete at this level.

Senior Novice Class: This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have NOT won 6 first places in the same class with competition. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.

Senior Open Class: This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who HAVE won 6 first places with competition in the Senior Novice Class, and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

ATTENTION: CKC JUNIOR HANDLING RULES - EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2016-

Section 3.4.1 "Junior Handler with the exception of Pee Wees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handler Number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Competing* 1 2 3-5 6-9 10-12 13 or more Points 0 1 2 3 4 5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS, which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more than five points at a single show. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour BEFORE the start of the SHOW

EXTRACTS FROM THE DOG SHOW RULES SUBSTITUE JUDGE

3.3.1 - Substitute Judge - when an advertised judge will not be able to fulfill his assignment, permission from the CKC to substitute the judge is required.... Exhibitors affected by this change may withdraw their entries up to one hour before the judging of the breed, notice of withdrawal must be made in writing. All entry and listing fees for withdrawn dogs shall be refunded

ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES

8.5.8—In case of a judge change (substitute or overload) an exhibitor may enter a dog under the replacement judge providing that the dog is entered in one of the regular classes of a show being held at the same venue by the same club and has been assigned a competition number. A new entry, along with accompanying fees will be accepted by the Show Secretary up to ONE hour PRIOR to the start of the show (see sections 3.3.1, 3.5.1, 8.5.4)

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

8.7.1 An Exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry at any time up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by phone, but either written or electronic notification must be received by the show secretary no later than the official closing date. If written notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show

FEES

8.8.2 Tendering of a dishonoured cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

MOVING A DOG TO SPECIALS

8.9.3—When one or more all-breed and /or Specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to specials MUST be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled **start of the show** for which the dog is being moved up to.

BREEDS, CLASSES, AWARDS AND STAKES

12.2.1 Regular Official Classes: All classes must be divided by sex except for Specials Only. Only dogs entered in one of the regular, non-regular, or unofficial classes shall be allowed within the show precincts.

JUNIOR PUPPY: for dogs at least six months of age on the first day of the Show and under nine months of age on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY: for dogs 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.

12 - 18 MONTH CLASS: for dogs 12 - 18 months on the day of the shows.

CANADIAN BRED: shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/ breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards. Should the owner/breeder be unable to handle the dog in this class, the dog may be moved to the Open Class (at least one hour prior to the judging of the breed in question).

OPEN CLASS: shall be for all dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY: is for dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status including at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

MOVING DOGS TO "SPECIALS ONLY": A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or handler at least 1 hour prior to the opening of the show. NOTE: Class dogs may be moved to "Specials Only" as long as the registration number is on the "Move Up" Sheet.

12.6 NON REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES

BABY PUPPY CLASS: For dogs at least three months of age on the first day of the Show and under six months of age on the day of the show. Will compete for Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Best Baby Puppy in Group and Best Baby Puppy in Show . No points are

BEST VETERAN IN SHOW: For any dogs over 7 years of age. May be spayed or neutered. Will compete for Best Veteran in Breed & Best Veteran in Group on Saturday. Not eligible for Best of Breed. This class is judged after Best of Breed. No points are awarded. See 2013 Dog Show Rules 12.6.1.(b) and 12.1.6 (e)

EXHIBITION ONLY: for Baby Puppies (See 12.2.2 below) and all dogs 6 months or older of age and eligible for registration with the CKC.

ALTERED CLASS: Altered means dogs which have been spayed or neutered by veterinarian procedure. All Rules and Regulations in the Conformation Rules and Regulations shall apply to this class unless otherwise specified. Dogs must be over 6 months of age SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

Showing correct information on the entry forms is the responsibility of the entrants. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to the CKC rules. Entry forms must be the same size and format as those included or they will be rejected.

2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone entries WILL NOT be accepted. Email or fax entries will be accepted provided that they are on a recognized CKC entry form and are signed by the exhibitor or agent.

3. Post dated cheques ARE NOT acceptable. Tendering an NSF cheque or declined credit card as payment of entry fees shall be considered non payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A \$ 25.00 NSF SERVICE CHARGE WILL BE LEVIED ON ALL NSF CHEQUES AND INVALID OR DECLINED CREDIT CARDS

4. Entry fees WILL NOT be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, sick. lame, excused by the veterinarian or judge or barred from the competition because it has been entered incorrectly.

5. Withdrawal of entries prior to closing date: 8.7.1 An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry at any time up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone, but either written or electronic notification must be received by the show secretary no later than the official closing date and time as stated in the premium list. If written or electronic notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show.

6. The entry of a dog cannot be altered or cancelled after the entries close, except as provided by the Dog Show Rules.

After the closing of the entries, an identification/receipt will be emailed to each exhibitor or agent. Judging schedules may be downloaded at www.DogShow.ca within a reasonable time after closing date.

ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at the Show held under these regulations, is not subject to any indignities of any kind. The Show Committee shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the discipline committee shall have the authority to take action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

10. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either the dog, exhibitor or patron. The Show and Trials giving Club will not be liable for any loss or injury that may be sustained through the disappearance, loss, theft and/or death of dogs entered in the show under any circumstances.

11. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to compete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

- 12. EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: CKC RULE Discipline Conformation Rule Book 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, official, volunteer, or and participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee shall promptly reort to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- 13. ACCORDING TO CITY BY LAW, DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED OFF LEAD WITHIN CITY LIMITS. Exercise dogs only in the designated areas. Anyone not following STOP AND SCOOP POLICY will be excused from the shows and trials. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs, both inside and outside the show building. The Show Superintendent reserves the right to eject from the show anyone at the show at the show who does not cleanup after their dog.
