Entries must be made ONLINE through www.dogshow.ca. NO EMAIL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. ENTERIES AND E-TRANSFERS SENT DIRECTLY TO THE SECRETARY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

Refunds will be given for bitches in season. Veterinary certificate must be submitted by May 1 2022 5pm.

Refunds will be given if the trial is cancelled due to COVID-19 restrictions or if an exhibitor provides confirmation of their COVID-19 positive test within 14 days of the trial date.

Move Ups will be allowed. Move ups must be sent to the Secretary by e-mail **NO LATER THAN WEDNESDAY APRIL 27 8:00 p.m**.

One handler may enter a maximum of two dogs.

When entries close on April 27 2022, you will receive instructions **VIA EMAIL** on any current public health restrictions for our area. In addition, a waiver which must be completed and submitted on the day of the trial. **Please note Companion Dog training requires a valid vaccine passport.**

Awards

Qualifying flat ribbons will be awarded for each element and New Title Rosettes will be offered for completion of a new title. Ribbons will be awarded at the end of Novice and at the end of Open class.

CKC Rules on Unsportsmanlike Conduct

4.1.5: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred."

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material. **All dogs must be on leash** at all times. Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.
