The following Sweepstakes classes divided by sex will be offered: Junior Puppies - 6 months to under 9 months on the day of sweepstakes.

Senior Puppies - 9 months to under 12 months on the day of the sweepstakes.

Open - 12 months to under 18 months on the day of the sweepstakes.

First will be chosen in each class and the six (6) class winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite in Sweepstakes.

Best in Sweepstakes - 15% of the entry money

Best of Opposite in Sweepstakes - 10% of the entry money

Classes: 1st-20%, 2nd-15%, 3rd-10%, 4th-5%, of the entry for that class. 25% will be retained by the Central Ontario Region, NDCC for administration.

VETERAN **SWEEPSTAKES** Veteran Sweepstakes: Shall be for any Newfoundland 7 years of age or older. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete in Veterans provided they are also entered in Exhibition Only. The dog must be entered in one the C.K.C. Regular Classes, Specials Only, Working Dog Class or Exhibition Only.

The following Veteran Sweepstakes classes divided by sex will be offered: 7 yrs to 9 yrs - 7 yrs of age to under 9 yrs of age on the day of the sweepstakes 9 yrs and over - 9 years of age or older on the day of the sweepstakes.

First will be chosen in each class and the four (4) class winners will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite in

Veteran Sweepstakes.

Best in Veteran Sweepstakes - 15% of the entry money

WORKING DOG: An unofficial class for Newfoundlands with at least one Canadian Working Dog/Obedience Title. For this class Obedience titles will be considered a Working title. Newfoundlands entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

(REGIONAL)

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS: Shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age on the day of the show and under 9 months on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS: Shall be for dogs 9 months of age on the day of the show and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.

12 TO 15 MONTH CLASS: Shall be for dogs 12 months of age on the day of the show and under 15 months of age on the day of the show.

15 to 18 MONTH CLASS: Shall be for dogs 15 months of age on the day of the show and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

CANADIAN BRED CLASS: Shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded.

BŘED BÝ EXHIBITOR CLASS: Shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

OPEN CLASS: Shall be for all dogs. Divided BLACK / LANDSEER, entry form must indicate.

VETERANS: Shall be for dogs seven years and older on the day of the show. Divided: 7 to 9 years and 9 years and over. These dogs compete for the regular placements and the 1st place dog and bitch in each class will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winners of the Veterans Classes will not compete for Championship Points.

SPECIALS ONLY: Shall be for dogs of any country having attained their Canadian Championship.

NOTE: Specials Class: Moving a dog to the Specials Class. Chapter 61; Section 8 of the dog show rules has been amended to allow a dog which is INDIVIDU-ALLY REGISTERED OR HAS AN ERN in the records of the CKC, and has completed the requirements of a Championship, after the closing date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the request for the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW, by the owner or handler.

SEXUALLY ALTERED: Eligibility for the altered classes shall be limited to dog/bitches over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure.

There shall be only one class for sexually altered males and one class for sexually altered females. The two Winners shall compete for Best Altered in Breed. There will be no Best Puppy in Breed. There will be a Reserve Altered Winners in both sexes.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

STUD DOG AND BROOD BITCH CLASSES: Entry to consist of Dog or Bitch and TWO of their progeny. Judging shall be based on the quality of the progeny only. Entry in these classes need not be the property of the same owner although all must be entered in one of the Official classes or in "Specials Only" or "Exhibition Only". Entry of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must be indicated on the Entry form. Name of the progeny need not be indicated on the Entry form.

AWARD OF MERIT

One Award of Merit will be given, at the judge's discretion, for each ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be presented following the Best of Breed judging.

TRACKING FEE

Effective January 1, 2011 the CKC instituted a tracking fee for all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members. In order to protect any points and awards earned at any CKC event, a resident non-member can chose to become a CKC member or pay the tracking fee of \$55.00 for each dog. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. This applies to dogs wholly owned by non members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member.

The following official CKC classes Draft Dog Brace Draft Dog

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

Draft Dog: Open to all Newfoundlands over eighteen months of age on the day of the test, registered with the CKC or eligible for such registration.

Brace Draft Dog: Open to all Newfoundlands, registered with the CKC or having an ERN. In order to compete as a Brace each dog that makes up the Brace team must have previously earned a CKC Draft Dog (DD) title. It is acceptable to enter as a Brace even if one dog has already earned a BDD title. It is acceptable for each dog to have separate owners while competing as one team.

GROUP OPTION

The Group Option as stated in Section 11.2 is not offered at this test.

EQUIPMENT

To be supplied by the entrant Be prepared for any weather. This event is entirely outdoors and there is no provision for cover in case of inclement weather.

QUALIFYING SCORE

To earn a Draft Dog Title or Brace Draft Dog Title at this test the entrant will be required to successfully pass all the exercises as written in the Draft Dog Test Rules and Regulations, in the eyes of all three judges.

During the test, the decision of the judges shall be final in all matters affecting the working of dogs and handlers and in evaluation of their performance.

BITCHES IN SEASON -DRAFT DOG TEST

An exhibitor may if desired request a refund for a bitch that has come into season after closing. A veterinarian's certificate will be required before a refund will be processed. Bitches in season may compete, but will be judged after all other entrants have been tested. These bitches must be kept away from the test site prior to being tested

DRAFT DOG RULES

It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge is not subject to indignities. The Test Committee Chairperson shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit an receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show. This event is held under the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club. Only Newfoundlands entered in the specialty will be allowed on the show grounds. All dogs must be on leash. Signs will be posted. The Newfoundland Dog Club of Canada will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.

Owners or handlers are responsible for clean up after their dogs. An area will be provided on site.

Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes will be judged before regular classes on the day of the show. The classes will be held outdoors and no cover will be provided in case of inclement weather.

The Show Site will open at 7:00 a.m. on the day of the show. All regular and non-regular classes will be judged outdoors and no cover will be provided in case of inclement weather.

An error in an age specified class, the class, date of birth, or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

Cancellation of any entry after closing day and time is prohibited. The Club reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Rules.

Telephone entries cannot be accepted except in the case of a postal disruption. Confirmation of entry and Judging Schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the closing.

(NATIONAL)

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS: Shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age on the day of the show and under 9 months on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS: Shall be for dogs 9 months of age on the day of the show and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.

12 TO 15 MONTH CLASS: Shall be for dogs 12 months of age on the day of the show and under 15 months of age on the day of the show.

15 to 18 MONTH CLASS: Shall be for dogs 15 months of age on the day of the show and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

CANADIAN BRED CLASS: Shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS: Shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

OPEN CLASS: Shall be for all dogs. Divided BLACK / LANDSEER, entry form must indicate.

VETERANS: Shall be for dogs seven years and older on the day of the show. These dogs compete for the regular placements and the 1st place dog and bitch will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for Championship Points.

SPECIALS ONLY: Shall be for dogs of any country having attained their Canadian Championship.

NOTE: Specials Class: Moving a dog to the Specials Class. Chapter 61: Section 8 of the dog show rules has been amended to allow a dog which is INDIVIDU-ALLY REGISTERED OR HAS AN ERN in the records of the CKC, and has completed the requirements of a Championship, after the closing date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the request for the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW. by the owner or handler.

AWARD OF MERIT

One Award of Merit will be given, at the judge's discretion, for each ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be presented following the Best of Breed judging.

DOG SHOW RULES

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and obeying the Dog Show Rules of the Canadian Kennel Club.

Chapter 8 - Section 3.3 of the Dog Show Rules states: A judge officiating at a show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to The Canadian Kennel Club any infringement of this Rule, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this Rule has been violated.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

PRE-NOVICECLASS-shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which have not earned the title of P.C.D. in Canada, Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may be entered in Pre-Novice that has of earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice classes.

NOVICE A CLASS- shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which have not earned the title of CD in Canada or any other country. A dog shall not be entered in a Novice class once it has been exhibited in an Open class. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. No professional handler or trainer, or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

NOVICE B CLASS-shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which have not earned the title of ČD in Čanada. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog that has earned the title of C.D., or a comparable title in any other country, but has not earned its title of C.D. in Canada, may only be entered in the Novice B Class.

OPEN A CLASS-shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which have earned the title of CD in Canada but have not earned the title of C.D.X. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families and must be eligible to handle under S.10.1 .3. No professional handler or trainer, or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

OPEN B CLASS-shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which shall have earned the title of C.D. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B classes at any one trial.

UŤILITY CLASS A-shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which shall have earned the title of CDX in Canada. Dogs in this class must be handled or exhibited by the owner or immediate family member. However, the same person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person that has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a MOTCH title may NOT handle in this class

UTILITY CLASS B-shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which shall have earned the title of CDX in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. However, the same person must handle the dog in all exercises.

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN UTILITY A AND B CLASSES AT THE SAME TRIAL

BITCHES IN Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in the Obedience Trial. Refunds SEASON less C.K.C. Fees will be given for bitches in season. Notification must be made **OBEDIENCE** to the Trial Secretary prior to the day of the trial and be accompanied by a TRIAL veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within 10 days preceding the trial.


OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

STUD DOG AND BROOD BITCH CLASSES: Entry to consist of Dog or Bitch and TWO of their progeny. Judging shall be based on the quality of the progeny only. Entry in these classes need not be the property of the same owner although all must be entered in one of the Official classes or in "Specials Only" or "Exhibition Only". Entry of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must be indicated on the Entry form. Name of the progeny need not be indicated on the Entry form. BRACE CLASS: Shall be for two dogs, (not necessarily the same sex) but must have identical ownership. A spayed/neutered dog may be entered in the Brace Class and must be entered in a Regular Class, or in Exhibition Only. PARADE OF CHAMPIONS: Newfoundlands in Parade must have completed all requirements for a C.K.C. Championship. Dog must be entered in one of Official classes or in "Specials Only" or "Exhibition Only".

PARADE OF VETERANS: Open to all Newfoundlands seven (7) years of age or older. Dog must be entered in one of the Official classes or in "Specials Only" or "Exhibition Only". There is no charge for Parade of Veterans.

NOTE: Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in the Parade of Champions and/or the Parade of Veterans.

Entry in any Non-Regular class must be indicated on the Entry Form, and any dog entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the Official Classes or in "Specials Only" or "Exhibition Only".

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

All dogs must be entered in a C.K.C. Regular class. Champions from any country excluded.

The following Sweepstakes classes divided by sex will be offered: Junior Puppies - 6 months to under 9 months on the day of sweepstakes. Senior Puppies - 9 months to under 12 months on the day of the sweepstakes. Open - 12 months to under 18 months on the day of the sweepstakes. First will be chosen in each class and the six (6) class winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite in Sweepstakes.

Best in Sweepstakes - 15% of the entry money

Best of Opposite in Sweepstakes - 10% of the entry money

Classes: 1st- 20%, 2nd- 15%, 3rd- 10%, 4th- 5%, of the entry for that class.

25% will be retained by the NDCC for administration.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes: Shall be for any Newfoundland 7 years of age or older. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete in Veterans provided they are also entered in Exhibition Only. The dog must be entered in one the C.K.C. Regular Classes, Specials Only or Exhibition Only.

The following Veteran Sweepstakes classes divided by sex will be offered: 7 yrs to 9 yrs - 7 yrs of age to under 9 yrs of age on the day of the sweepstakes 9 yrs and over - 9 years of age or older on the day of the sweepstakes. First will be chosen in each class and the four (4) class winners will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite in

Veteran Sweepstakes.

Best in Veteran Sweepstakes - 15% of the entry money

Best of Opposite in Veteran Sweepstakes - 10% of the entry money Classes: 1st- 20%, 2nd- 15%, 3rd- 10%, 4th- 5%, of the entry for that class.


