Specialty Classes

Regular Classes:

The following regular classes will be provided (divided by sex) for all specialties:

Baby Puppy (3 - 6 months of age)

Junior Puppy (6 - 9 months of age)

Senior Puppy (9 - 12 months of age) 12 - 18 months

Canadian Bred (dogs born in Canada) Open

Bred by Exhibitor, (handler must be the breeder/owner of the dog)

Specials Only (dogs which are Canadian Champions)

Veteran (7 - 10 yrs of age) & (10+ yrs of age) (dogs may be spayed or neutered)

Exhibition Only

Non-Regular Classes

Dogs entered in any non-regular class must also be entered in a regular class of or for Exhibition Only - except Stud Dog and Brood Bitch whose get/progeny MUST be entered in a Regular Class. **Stud Dog**: for any sire and 2 or more of his get. Sire and get need not be owned by the same

person.

Brood Bitch: Same as above for any dam and 2 or more of her progeny.

Brace: for 2 dogs of either sex, need not be owned by the same person, but must be handled by one person on one lead

Gun Dog: For all Labrador Retrievers who have earned a Certificate of Merit or better at a Licensed Field Trial, or who have received a Junior Hunter Title or higher, a Working Certificate or higher, in Canada or the United States by the close of entries.



Junior Handling offered Saturday August 20/2016 JUDGE: Becky Dannaker

Judging will commence following all unofficial classes

Conformation classes offered: Pee Wee (non-competitive); Junior Novice, Intermediate Novice, Senior Novice, Junior Open, Intermediate Open, Senior Open.

Awards: Rosettes & Prizes for first to fourth in each class and for Best Overall. Sign up Forms will be available Saturday morning

Notice to CKC Clubs & Junior Handlers Re: Junior Handler Numbers

Please note that effective January 1, 2016, in accordance with Section 3.4.1 of the Junior

Handling Rules & Regulations, Junior Handlers will be required to apply to CKC Head Office for
a Junior Handling Number.

Section 3.4.1 "Junior Handler with the exception of PeeWees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked." The Application for a Junior Handler Number is posted on the CKC website under the Events tab, and then under Event Forms, Exhibitor, or Event Supplies, Junior Handling. This application can be mailed, faxed, or emailed to CKC Head Office and there is no fee.

Judge Mrs. **Becky Dannaker**: (Divided By Sex) Open to all breeder/owner/handlers regardless of class entered. The breeder/owner/handler **must handle the dog at each level** of the competition.

<u>Prizes</u> - 1^{st} place - 30%, 2^{nd} place - 20%, 3^{rd} place - 15%, 4^{th} place - 10% for each class. A Rosette will be awarded for Best in Sweepstakes & Best of Opposite Sex. Flat ribbons will be awarded for 1^{st} through 4^{th} place in each class. The balance of 25% will be retained for Administration.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- a)An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b)In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.
- c)The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS - ERN NUMBERS

Effective Jan. 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an event registration number (ERN). This ERN number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN number, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or VISA/Mastercard number, (expiry date, cardholders name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of ERN number. Cost \$55.00. ERN number must be applied for within 30 DAYS of the FIRST day of entering a CKC event.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- 2. ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED AFTER CLOSING DATE. Receipts, judging schedules, and exhibitor passes can be retrieved from the dogshow.ca website www.dogshow.ca
- 3. 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. Rule 19.7
- 4. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WHILE ON THE GROUNDS. You are responsible for cleaning up if you permit your dog to relieve itself. Failure to do so may result in being expelled for one day's showing by the Superintendent.
- 5. SHOW PRECINCTS: Lakedell Ag Society
- 7. "ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching



CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Section 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing 8**	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

^{**} includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule as set forth above. The new system provides for additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog, either at the breed level or at the group level, if a dog awarded WINNERS also placed in the Group, as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than 5 points at any single show.








DIRECTIONS TO SHOW:
