Please include this with your entry fees. There will only be one stakeout fee charged for the weekend. If you are attending the trial as well you only pay for one event.

ALSO, ALL PARTICIPANTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SIGN A LANDOWNER WAIVER. THIS WAIVER MUST BE SUPPLIED AHEAD OF TIME AT THE REQUEST OF THE LAND OWNER. PLEASE INCLUDE YOUR SIGNED COPY WITH YOUR ENTRIES. ALL OTHERS WHO ENTER THE GROUNDS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SIGN A WAIVER PRIOR TO ENTERING OR ENGAGING IN ANY ACTIVITIES ON THE GROUNDS.

U.S. exhibitors: Our bank will not accept cheques marked "payable in Canadian funds". Entry fees must be paid in Canadian Funds.

LISTING FEE: A listing fee as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. This listing fee is \$10.50 per dog per each event entered during the field test and is in addition to the entry fee(s). Exhibitors should be aware that the CKC does not confer a title on any dog until it is registered individually in their records.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to confirm that The Secretary has received their entries.

NOTE: In the case of electronic or telephone entries, the entry is not considered complete until fee is paid and a signed entry form is received by the Test Secretary.

All entry forms must be in the hands of the Field Test Secretary BY THE CLOSING DATE and entry fees paid in full. There will be no exceptions.

While we will have a PayPal service set up for this event, it is highly recommended you use Dogshow.ca. Please take advantage of this service. Please go to www.gspalberta.com for PayPal entries.

Entries close 7:00 P.M., Tuesday, May 3rd , 2022. Draw will be held on Wednesday, May 4th, 2022 at 8:00 pm at the home of the test Secretary: ([call Field Test Secretary for directions](#)). Running order will be emailed to handlers by no later than Friday May 3rd. If you do not have an email address, please call the test secretary to obtain a schedule of running order.

All entries for the Field Test are accepted on condition that the GSPFCA, its officials and members, and the land (McNair Ranchlands Ltd.) and horse owners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by dog, horse or person in conjunction with, or during the running of, this field test. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of a parent or guardian.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Test Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating this has occurred.

TEST INFORMATION:

- **Courses & Birds** - Partridge, Quail and/or pheasant will be released. The tests will be over a single course with birds released along the course. There will not be a bird field. Three birds will be released for the first dog tested and two birds per dog thereafter. In FDX 5 birds will be released for the first brace and two birds per dog after that. The GSPFCA reserves the right in case of a bird shortage, to use alternate bird species.
- **Horses on the course** - Bird planters, marshals and judges may use horses. All other participants must be on foot. **All dogs will be handled on foot**
- **All persons on the course in FD, FDA and FDX must wear a blaze orange garment. A hat alone will not be allowed. If you do not have one, one will be provided.**
- **Gallery:** At the discretion of the judges and handlers
- Total entries will be limited to the **number of dogs** that can be run in approximately 6 hours on Saturday and 8 hours Sunday of judging time. Entries will close and a waiting list will be started once this limit is reached
- **Starting times** will be announced. (Earliest start will be 8 am.) Running times are an estimate only and may change due to absentees or dogs "picked up" early. It is the handler's responsibility to be at the start of the course when it is their turn to run.
- **FDJ & FD** dogs will have **20-30 minutes** to complete all aspects of the test. **FDA** dogs will have **30-40 minutes**. **FDX** dogs will have **30-45 minutes**. Dogs will be run individually in the FDJ & FD Tests; FDA and FDX dogs will be run in braces.
- **Firearms** - Official gunners will be the only persons permitted to carry firearms on the test site. In FD, FDA & FDX, shotguns will be fired over dogs with bird work when possible. Shooting will be done by **official gunners** only. In FDJ blank shells will be fired – please **provide your own starting pistol**.
- Bitches **in season** will be permitted to run in FDJ on both days and in the final braces on course 1 Sunday afternoon only. Please notify the secretary or test chair if you have a bitch in season.
- **Collaring** a dog is allowed with the permission of the judge.
- **Tracking collars:** Tracking collars will be permitted. Only tracking collars that meet the CKC guidelines will be allowed.

A dog that is located using a tracking collar during its heat is no longer under judgement.

- **Training or exercising** of dogs is prohibited on the test grounds during the test weekend (from Friday evening until completion of judging on Sunday).
- **Smoking** is prohibited except in the designated camping or headquarters area.
- **Accommodation:** Minimal Camping will be allowed on the grounds in the area specified. Please do not leave the trail with your vehicles while driving on the pasture. Facilities are limited, come prepared. Outhouse is provided.
- **NO OPEN FIRES WILL BE ALLOWED, PERIOD**

- **Food:** There will be no food or beverages available for participants. Please bring your own
- **Prizes** - Rosettes will be awarded to all qualifying dogs. All ribbons are to be claimed at the Test – no ribbons will be mailed
- All participants must be familiar with CKC Rules and Regulations and also the rules, conditions and provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Test Rules are available from the CKC. **NOTE: Make sure you review the rules for Field Dog Tests (available on the CKC website: www.ckc.ca)**

COVID 19

Due to the Covid 19 Pandemic the club will be adhering to all recommended guidelines in the Province of Alberta. Since this is an outdoor event masks will not be mandatory but please respect the physical distancing (2M) guidelines and other people's space.

General guidelines to be followed:

1. Practice physical distancing consistent with guidelines in effect (2m) at the time of the event. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
2. Wash hands as frequently as possible. We will have disinfecting spray and or wipes at bathroom facilities for people to spray door handles (or anything else they touch).
3. If you have tested positive in the 10 days prior to the event, you will not be permitted to attend this event.

Other things to remember:

1. There will be no hospitality or concession food available. We will be supplying food for judges and helpers
2. Bring water and food for yourself and your dogs.
3. The Club is grateful to have the use of these grounds. We ask for your co-operation in keeping the grounds free of litter by using the garbage bags provided. Parking will be restricted to the marked areas and

limited if grounds are wet. No smoking will be allowed on the trial grounds. Smoking is only permitted in your parked vehicle.

4. If your dog poops, please scoop and dispose in the provided garbage bags or consider packing out your own refuse.
