The VIPDC will conduct approved CKC Field Dog Test for all pointing breeds on October 1, 2023 at Cowichan Exhibition Grounds, 7830 Trans-Canada HWY, Duncan BC, V9L6B1. The Tests are held under the pointing breeds Field Trial and Field Dog Test Rules and Regulations, effective January 1, 2020, of the Canadian Kennel Club, Suite 400-200 Robson Drive, Etobicoke, Ontario, M9W 529

This test is considered a qualifier for our annual Wing to Ring VIPDC Specialty Show for Pointing breeds held in conjunction with the Victoria City Kennel Club Shows March 2024. Rules of Eligibility: A dog must have entered and participated in a VIPDC Field Dog Test from April 2023 up to and including February 29, 2024 in order to be eligible to enter the VIPDC Conformation Specialty Show in March 2024. Dogs must complete the full allotted time on the field or be endorsed by the Wing to Ring judge if the full allotted time is not complete. These Tests are open to dogs not entered in the Specialty Show. Priority will be given to dogs entered in the Specialty Show, then to VIPDC Members.

Courses and Birds: All courses will be single course without Bird Field. Chukar will be released throughout the course for all tests. In the advent of adverse course conditions the Field Test Chairman may adjust the course.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All Tests are walking Tests. Blank pistols, .22 cal minimum will be fired over all
 dogs with bird work. No live ammunition will be allowed in any test. Pistols
 must have solid barrels. Please provide your own or arrange to borrow one
 before you take your dog to the start line.
- Total entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in the available daylight hours.
- The Club will accept Day Of entries if there is time and birds available. Please speak to the VIPDC Event Secretary and note there will be an additional \$10 fee.
- The Club reserves the right to rearrange the running order of the Tests should conditions warrant.
- With the permission of the judge, collaring will be allowed.
- Bitches in season will be permitted to run, at the end of the day. Entrants must notify the event secretary prior to the start of said test, or run will be forfeited.
- Tracking Collars: Approved electronic collars may be used. Any questions regarding their use should be referred to the Field Test Chairman.
- All participants must be familiar with the CKC Rules and also the rules and provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Test rulebooks are available from the CKC or on-line at the CKC website for CKC members. Link to Rules
- Chewing or eating a bird at any time during a Test will result in an automatic failure at any Field Dog Test level. (11.7)
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the Test-giving Club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or competitor at a Field Test is not subject to indignities. The Field Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- The Vancouver Island Pointing Dog Club is committed to providing an environment free of discrimination and harassment, where all individuals are treated with respect. Members and participants are expected to be respectful at all times. Harassment, discrimination, physical and verbal assault by anyone will not be tolerated, condoned, or ignored within our membership or at any event sponsored or hosted by the Vancouver Island Pointing Dog Club. Any such claims will be reviewed by the Board. If a claim of harassment or discrimination is determined, disciplinary measures will be applied, up to and including termination of membership, or suspension from participation in future events for a length of time as determined by the Board.

PRIZES: Standard CKC rosettes will be awarded to the qualifying dogs in all Field tests, as appropriate. Due to Covid-19, we will attempt to get your scores and ribbons to you as quickly as possible after your run so you may leave the grounds if you wish.

LISTING FEE: A listing fee of \$10.50 as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN), Performance Event Number (PEN) is not shown on the entry form. This listing fee is per dog per each event entered during the Field Test and is in addition to the entry fee(s).

All entries are accepted on the condition that the Vancouver Island Pointing Dog Club, its officers, directors, membership and landowners assume no responsibility for participants or spectators in the event of injury or damage to persons, animals, or properties in conjunction with or during the running of the Field Test. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of the parent or guardian.

BORDER CROSSING: A rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into or out of Canada and the rabies certificate must be dated at least 30 days prior to crossing the border.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011 Non-member participation fee
