Fees and Payment

Event Fees (including G.S.T.) per Entry Junior = \$50.00 Qualifying = \$55.00

Temporary Competition Numbers(TCN) FEE: A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN or (Canine Companion Number) CCN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called listing fees) when entering events using this number.

All entry fees must be paid in full prior to the start of the test.

A separate entry form for <u>Each Dog</u> in <u>Each Stake</u> is required. Multiple entries on a single form will <u>NOT</u> be accepted.

Running order:

Dogs and bitches will be run in the order of the draw. Rule 6.6.1.c provides that "in a stake carrying championship points, a system of rotation must be implemented..." In the Open and Amateur stakes the starting order will rotate 25% of the entered field, rounded upward, with the provision that no dog will be required to be the starter for two series.

Starting numbers:

The order of running in the Open and Amateur stakes shall be in the order of the draw beginning with the dog determined using the S&P/TSX Composite Index closing number on the Tuesday preceding the trial. Please contact the Field Trial Secretary to receive a written explanation of the system. We will advise all contestants with E-mail addresses of the starting number on Wednesday, May 30, 2012.

Release and Indemnification of Landowners:

By entering this trial, each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the trial and agrees to release, save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) of any property upon which the trial is held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participant's use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participant, or his heirs, his executors and assigns.
