

ADDITIONAL RULES GOVERNING SHOW & TRIALS

- The Club reserves the right to remove any persons from the Show / Trials. The Show / Trial Superintendent shall have full control of the event which will be governed by Canadian Kennel Club Rules. The Authorities of this show may decline to accept entries and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the Show / Trials on account of disease or viciousness.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the Show / Trials cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- The Show / Trial Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, loss or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 4. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children during theses Show / Trials.
- 5. The owner of a dog entered in these Show / Trials is entirely responsible for any error in entering his dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- Dogs entered in the OPEN CLASS must have a CKC Individual Registration Number, a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN), or for Miscellaneous breeds a CKC Certification Number. Miscellaneous breeds may compete only at the Novice level as Listed Dogs.
- 7. In the NOVICE A and OPEN A classes no licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through to its UD title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete as an exhibitor in these classes. One dog only may be entered in these classes by any one exhibitor, and every dog must be handled by its owner or a member of the immediate famly. A dog which has earned its CD or CDX in the USA, Bermuda or a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in the "A" Classes. Such dogs must be entered in the "B" Classes.
- 8. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds. All dogs must be kept on leash except when in the obedience ring.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Dogs are to be exercised in DESIGNATED AREAS only.
- 10. Any dog excused by the Show / Trial Chairman or the Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the Show / Trials.
- 11. Obedience and Rally Only Full refund of entry and listing fees will be made for a BITCH that comes into SEASON after the close of entries if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary at lease ONE HOUR BEFORE the start of the TRIALS.
- 12. Any person, either within or outside the judging ring, who does anything calculated to attract or distract or otherwise affect in any way the attention, of department, or performance of a dog under judgment, may be disciplined by the Discipline Committee in whatever way it considers in the best interests of the Club, of the Judge may take summary actions.
- 13. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
