Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

#### NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEES ARE IN EFFECT

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number.

In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Tantramar Kennel Club will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.

The superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials.

Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.

Due to the limited amount of space, the superintendent may be required to control the number of and/or area taken up by x-pens. All exhibitors are required to co-operate with the superintendent in this regard.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the

Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the TKC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows/Trials, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Only dogs entered in the Shows & Trials will be permitted in the building.

Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.

Champions and championship points - chapter 15

Section 1 - a dog awarded winners at a championship show held under these rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging 0-5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder: Section 2:

A class dog awarded best in show at an all breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.
