If TDXs do not fill, the club will substitute the allowable number of TDs pursuant to CKC Tracking Test Rules & Regulations January 1, 2017, Article 3.2.1. provided that entries are received by the closing date. (1 TDX = 2 TDs)

Rules and Regulations of the FPOTC

PAYMENT: Please make all cheques or money orders payable to Forbidden Plateau Obedience & Tracking Club. A listing fee of \$10.00 must accompany payment if the dog entered does not have C.K.C. number.

U.S. entrants may pay fees by money order made payable in Canadian funds or personal cheque in U.S. funds for the full amount of the fee(s). Personally discounted cheques will not be accepted. Please **DO NOT** mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "at par" as these are not readily cleared by the banks. Tendering an NSF or post-dated cheque will be considered as non-payment of fee(s) and will subject the maker of the cheque to a \$15.00 "handling fee" and disciplinary action.(C.K.C.)

Due to the limited entry we shall be accepting entries by <u>MAILONLY</u>, with only **one** entry per envelope. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Entrants will be notified by phone or email that their entry has been received. Entry fees will be returned within 10 days of the day of the test to Alternates who did not participate in the test.

DRAW FOR ENTRY: A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date and time will take place to determine placement in the test or on to an Alternate list. The drawing will be at **7:00 p.m. on Friday**, **September 27th, 2019 at Tim Horton's, 789 Ryan Road (by Superstore).**

CLUB WORKER OPTION: At the entry draw, one TDX track will be reserved per CKC Rule 6.6.2. "Club Worker" is defined by FPO&TC Policy (one worker track for every four tracks offered).

INTERCHANGE of TRACKS: Entry submissions may be made for TD speculating that an interchange of tracks may occur. These submissions will be received and held as a separate category and drawn in order as potential alternates in the event an interchange of tracks occurs.

MEETING PLACE AND DRAW: Rendezvous is scheduled for **9:30 a.m. on Saturday, October 12th at Tim Horton's, 789 Ryan Road (by Superstore)**, where the draw for tracks will take place. Any primary entrant(s) who is absent at this time will forfeit their position to the first Alternate present.

BITCHES IN SEASON may compete, however, they will run last. Please advise the Test Secretary upon arrival.

AWARDS & NO-HOST LUNCHEON: A no-host luncheon will be held following the tracking test at which time the Judge will present ribbons to all the successful teams. Also, the Club will award keepsake trophies to those same teams.

REFUNDS: When an entered dog is withdrawn after the closing date, refunds will **only** be permitted when the vacancy is accepted by an "Alternate". If a position becomes available, Alternates will be contacted in catalogue order and asked to either accept or decline the position. (i.e. if #1 declines #2 will be contacted, etc.)

RULE 14.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Tracking Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Limitation of Liability: In attending this test, competitors, spectators and guests acknowledge they do so at their own risk and that of any dog. They also agree, upon submitting an entry form, that they will not hold liable the CKC, the FPOTC or its officials, the Judge or the landowner(s) for any loss, damage or injury, however arising, to themselves, their dog(s) or any other chattels.

Effective January 1, 2011 Non-Member Participation Fee

- * A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of CKC.
- The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
 In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the
- non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- * All Premium lists will carry a note stating the fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.
