** All times listed are Eastern DAYLIGHT Time**

Building Hours & Set-Up Times:

The show building will be open for set-up 6 pm to 10 pm on Thursday, April 28th. NO EARLY BIRDS PLEASE! The building will be open each day at 7:00 am.

The building will close at 10:00 pm each night....and 2 hours after BIS on Sunday.

Please Note...new management...no longer can there be any dogs past the bleachers, or behind the boards.

Exercise-Pens:

Space is limited and Exercise-Pens will NOT be allowed. With the exception of crates for the giant breeds, exhibitors should have stackable crates. Soft sided crates will be allowed only if space permits.

<u>Power:</u> Power in the Unreserved grooming areas is available at a cost of \$10/exhibitor. You will receive a tag for your cord at the show secretary's desk. <u>Untagged cords will be Unplugged!!!!!</u>

Canteen:

The canteen upstairs will be open during show hours.

Arm Bands:

Pick up all armbands at the Show Secretary's desk. The LKC armband is for all 3 days plus puppy sweeps. There are separate armbands for each Specialty.

Non-Smoking Venue:

This is a non-smoking venue. There will be an ash-can outside the big doors. Please don't leave cigarette butts on the ground....burned paws hurt!!!!

Attention U.S. Exhibitors: A Passport, or specially enhanced driver's license is required to get home! A current Rabies certificate is required for each dog.

There is currently a total ban on any dog food that contains beef or beef by-products, as well as lamb and customs will allow NO exceptions. All dog food being brought into Canada MUST be in UNOPENED original bags, with a readable label of ingredients.

Weather: Bring Warm clothes!!!!!

Totally unpredictable!!! Some years it is like summer....other years we get a snow storm! So, be prepared!

Ramps & Tables: A ramp will be available should a judge require one.

CKC Rules: At the discretion of the judge, designated ramp breeds (See Appendix H – List of Breeds that may be judged on a ramp) may be examined on the ground or on a ramp. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner on the ramp or on the ground.

Breeds not designated as either table or ramp breeds are customarily examined on the ground. At the discretion of the judge, ramps may be used to judge any breed. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner.

<u>Bait for sale:</u> The Pembroke Welsh Corgi Club of Canada will have bait for sale at the show...cooked chicken wieners as well as liver.
