American cheques will be accepted but in the full amount of the entry and not discounted. We suggest it be paid by Postal or bank money order in Canadian funds. AMERICAN CHEQUES CAN BE ACCEPTED PLEASE E-MAIL FOR INSTRUCTIONS.
- ALL ENTRIES will be accepted until the official closing date, even though advertised limit has been reached. In accordance with the Tracking Test Regulations: When the advertised limit has been reached, all remaining entries shall be assigned a position on an alternate list in the order received. Alternates not successful will receive a full refund of fees within 10 days of the test. A refund of entry fees will also be given to any confirmed entry that does not participate in the test, provided that the test Superintendent is notified prior to the day of the test and provided that an alternate entry participates in the test as a result of the withdrawal. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.
- DOGS THAT ARE NOT ACTUALLY COMPETING WILL BE RESTRICTED AND ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH WELL AWAY FROM COMPETING DOGS
