<u>CANADIAN BRED</u> For dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must

be the owner/co-owner <u>and</u> breeder/co-breeder of the dog.The owner/breeder must handle the dog in *this* class, but need not handle

the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS TO BE DIVIDED: 1. FAWN

2. BRINDLE

VETERANS CLASS Dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show.

Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

SPECIALS Dogs who have a recorded CKC reg'n number or an ERNumber and

have attained the required points for Champion status. All awards earned at the show shall be cancelled if it is found that a dog is not registered or has not completed the requirements for a CKC

championship. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed,

Best Opposite, and Best Puppy, if eligible

<u>ALTERED CLASS</u> Dogs who have been surgically altered, and are over 6 months of age.

CLASS DIVIDED INTO MALE AND FEMALE ONLY

EXHIBITION ONLY CLASS Entries in this class may not compete in a Regular class, but may

compete in Non-Regular classes and events. Dogs may be spayed or

neutered.

NON REGULAR CLASSES

BRACE This class shall be for 2 dogs (not necessarily of the same sex or the

same owner, as of Jan.1/06) . Braces will be judged after Best of Breed. A brace should be judged as an identical pair..same colour, size, gait, stride. When viewed from the side, the 2 dogs should appear as one dog and its shadow. A brace must be handled by one person and on <u>one lead</u>. Dogs must be entered officially or for Exhibition Only.

Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

SIRE AND GETThis class shall be comprised of the stud dog and 2 or more of his get.

Ownership in this class need not be identical. The stud dog must be entered in a regular class or Exhibition Only, but the get must be entered in a regular class. Dogs entered in the Stud Dog and Get class may be spayed or neutered, and must be entered in a regular class as

outlined in these rules or for Exhibition Only.

DAM AND PROGENY This class shall have the same requirements as the Stud Dog and Get

class. Dogs entered in the Dam and Progeny class may be spayed or neutered, and must be entered in a regular class as outlined in these

rules, or for Exhibition Only.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge **shall** be included in the calculation as of Jan.1/06. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion, the dog must have earned at least one **2-point win either at the breed or group level.**

ERN NOTICE

Effective January 1992, all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and who enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number. The ERN (Event Registration Number) does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes, but rather enables a foreign-owned or foreign-born dog to be awarded titles for the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or FAX a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificatewith a cheque or VISA/Mastercard. Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. The cost is \$53.50. Dogs may initially be entered as "listed", but the ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to the consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted, and must be payable in Canadian funds. If a cheque is sent in US funds, it must be made out for the full required fees, and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "payable in Canadian funds", or "at par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money order payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- *All fees include GST and CKC service charges.
- *Over-payments will not be refunded.
- *There will be a \$45.00 service charge for any returned cheque or refused credit card.
- *Entries must be typed or clearly printed on CKC regulation size forms. Please use the form provided.
- *The Show Superintendent is in full charge of the Specialty, governed by CKC rules.
- *A judge officiating at a show under CKC rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. CKC rules: 6.3.3, 6.3.4, 6.3.5.
- *Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall not compete any further at the Specialty.
- *The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible, nor assume any liability, in the event of accident or misfortune, regardless of the cause.
- *It is the responsibility of the handler of any dog to be ready at ringside for judging. Handlers should report any absentees. Handlers must have assistants at ringside if they are to be engaged elsewhere. Judging will <u>NOT</u> be delayed.
- *Entries will be acknowledged as soon as possible after closing.
- *No dogs will be allowed on the premises unless entered in the Specialty or for the regular shows or trials.
- *Dogs must be exercised in the designated areas. Offenders may be removed from the show.
- *Dogs and children must be under control at all times.
- *Entries may be cancelled up until closing date, and cancellations must be in writing to the Show Secretary. No fees will be refunded after closing. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to enter their dogs correctly, and to check to see if FAXES have been received. Exhibitors must abide by their errors. The Show Secretary will not be responsible for any fax not received.
- *Moving dogs to Specials: must be done one hour prior to the opening of the Specialty Club Show.

Non Member Participation Fee

(April 2011)

- A non member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC.
- The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.
