Junior Puppy	-A dog between 6 months and under 9 months on the day of the show
Senior Puppy	-A dog between 9 months of age and 12 months on the day of the show.
12-18 Months	-A dog between 12 months of age and 18 months on the day of the show.
Canadian Bred	-A dog which is born in Canada.
Bred by Exhibitor	-The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog further for awards.
Open Class	-For all dogs.
Specials Only	-Dogs which have a recorded CKC registration or Event Registration Number (ERN) and have attained the required points for Championship Status. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy in Breed if eligible.

Friday & Saturday, November 15 & 16, 2013

The Ottawa Kennel Club is pleased to offer an UNOFFICIAL CLASS COMPETITION for breeders who enter the Bred By Exhibitor Class. **This class is open only to dogs entered in the "bred by" class.** There is no additional charge for this competition. Judging in this competition will be held after each official class is completed at the breed and group level, by the regular breed judge. Each winner will be eligible to compete for Best Bred by Exhibitor in his or her respective groups. Each group winner of the Best Bred by Exhibitor will be eligible to compete for Best Bred By Exhibitor in Show. A judge will judge best Bred by Exhibitor in Show upon completion of General Specials. A flat ribbon will be awarded at the breed level. A Rosette will be awarded to all Group winners in this competition. A gift & rosette will be awarded to the Best Bred By Exhibitor in Show.

OWNER HANDLED COMPETITION (OH) - RULES
Sunday, November 17, 2013

Rules for Owner Handled Competition

- Owner Handled Box must be checked** on entry form (A * will indicate each OH dog listed in both the catalogue and on the Judging sheets.)
- This is open to all **non-professional** owner-handler. Dogs must be OH throughout the competition.
- Judging of **OH** will take place after Breed Judging Competition.
- OH** Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs eligible to compete for BB.
- If the BB is **OH** it will automatically be the **OH BB**.
- If ineligible, then the next highest OH placement will compete against the eligible dogs of the opposite sex.
- Should none of the BB competitive dogs be **OH** then any **OH** dogs (not directly or indirectly defeated in the classes by an **OH** dog) will be invited back.
- The **OH BB** dogs will compete for **Best OH** in Group immediately after Regular Group Judging.
- Should the Regular Group 1st dog be **OH** then it will be automatically **OH in Group**.
- If no **OH** places in the Group (1-4) then all **BB OH** dogs will be called into the ring for **OH Group Judging**.
- If BIS dog is **OH**, then it will automatically be **OH BIS**
- A flat ribbon will be offered for Best OH in Breed, a Rosette for Best OH in Group and a Rosette and prize for Best OH in Show.

1. The show is being held in Hall 1.
2. Access times – Thurs.Nov.14th at 10:00 am for Vendors & RV parking – 3:00 pm for early set up.
3. All equipment MUST enter and leave the building through the shipping/receiving hallway at the rear of the building. NO equipment will be allowed through the main entrance of the Centre.
4. Parking is \$7.00 / day one time use only. In and out weekend passes, \$16.00 for 2 days and \$23.00 unlimited in and out for all three days. Parking passes MUST be pre-ordered and paid by closing of entries in order to obtain this special rate. Check off box on entry form
5. There is NO facility to bathe a dog on site.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

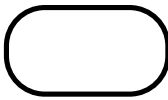

In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing:	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
POINTS ALLOCATED*	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

- *Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership - with a written request for an ERN.*
- *Include full payment in the amount of \$57.75. Accounts may be paid with personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or Mastercard. For Non-Members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates.*
- *Provide us with your full return address.*
- *Faxed requests will be accepted. Please include your VISA/MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature.*
- *An ERN must be obtained within 30 day of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibits this or presents a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension.*

- ! NO equipments will be allowed through the main entrance of the Centre.
- ! Crated dogs may be left overnight at the owner/agents risk. The hall will be securely locked at 11:00 pm and open at 7:00 am the next morning..
- ! No commercial activity may occur within any space without the express permission of the OKC Show Chair. Exhibitors are welcome to have appropriately sized signage indicating which breed they have on display.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEOTAPING

"Still photography and videotaping or filming will be conducted at the Ottawa Kennel Club show. Your entry in, or attendance at, the Ottawa Kennel Club show constitutes your permission and consent to the Ottawa Kennel Club and their assignees and licensees photographing, videotaping or filming to use the resulting photographic pictures, videotapes or films of yourself, your agents and/or your dogs for any purpose whatsoever and without payment or further release." No photography or videotaping may be conducted for the purpose of resale within the show precincts by anyone other than the official Show Photographer without express written consent from the Ottawa Kennel Club.
