### JUDGES BIOGRAPHIES

### **MICHAEL & SANDY GELINAS**

We started in purebred dogs together, acquiring our first show dog in 1975. "Petrol", a Doberman, won the breed from the classes at our first all-breed show ... we were hooked! Adding Cavaliers to our home in 1995 brought some humour and some hair! They are a good mix for us and a joy to live with. We have successfully shown our dogs in three countries, with many major specialty show wins in Canada and the United States. We have handled other breeds along the way, such as Alaskan Malamutes, Boxers, Whippets, Great Danes and Newfoundlands

Our judging careers started in the mid 90s. We have had the honour to judge specialty & all-breed assignments in Canada, United States, Mexico, Bermuda, Argentina and Australia. Michael achieved all-breed status in 2009 and Sandy in 2010. We are Life Members of the Canadian Kennel Club. Sandy served on the Events Officiating Committee which revamped the CKC qualification and education criteria for judges. We are long-time members of the

Elgin County Kennel Club & the Doberman Pinscher Club of Canada. We are also members of the Cavalier King Charles Club of Canada and founding members of the Monarch Kennel Club and the Thames Valley Doberman Pinscher Club; we serve on the executive of these clubs today.

In retrospect we have supported the fancy and our sport of showing dogs for all of our adult lives! We still breed Dobermans & Cavaliers occasionally, showing our dogs to their championships and know what it is to cherish a breeder/owner/handler win. Michael works as the Manager of Sales for a large building supply company, Sandy works as a Privacy Specialist for the London Health Science Centre.

### SUSAN J. QUESNEL

After acquiring my first Siberian Husky in 1972, the first litter of Atim Red. (perm) was whelped in 1975. My direction in this breed became sled dog racing and the education in structure and commitment to form and function followed. I also competed in the conformation ring and finished many champions that also were members of competitive racing teams.

In 1985 I added a Belgian Tervuren bitch to our household. Over the next 7 years the beauty, trainability and loyalty of the Belgian Shepherd became my focus and now Belgian Tervuren are my breed. My breeding program with a small kennel has produced National Specialty winners in US and Canada, all breed BIS winners, numerous Canadian and American conformation champions, HIT obedience dogs, agility title holders and Herding Trial winners.

Not to be forgotten was my interest in Pomeranians and I have had several that completed their championships and lived out their lives as valued companions. I am still actively breeding Tervuren and compete in conformation, agility and obedience and tracking. I have my judging license in Working, Toys, Herding, one half Non-Sporting and just finishing the last half of Non-Sporting Group.

### YVONNE SAVARD

Yvonne's start into the dog world was walking into the show ring as a Junior Handler with a big male Bouvier des Flandres at the 7 day benched Sportsman Show in Toronto Ontario in 1969. The love for Bouviers and dog shows remained with her from that day forward. Breeding Bouviers under the prefix "Barbu Perm Reg'd", she has also had the excitement of winning BOW at the American National Bouvier Specialty 5 times and being the owner of the Top Dog all Breeds in Canada in 1984. Yvonne has bred and shown multiple Best in Show winners both in Canada and the US. Although her main focus was Bouviers she has owned and shown Irish Setters, Doberman Pinschers, German Shepherds, and Pekingese. Yvonne handled and trained various breeds in her career with dogs. Yvonne's professional life has always involved animals in some way from Veterinary Medicine to Animal Welfare. Yvonne served on the ABdFC- Health Committee, is an approved Breed Mentor and is a 25+ year member ABdFC as well as President of the Canadian BdFC. She is one of the founding members of the Bouvier des Flandres Club of BC. Currently she is a Territory Manager for a Veterinary Pharmaceutical Company. She is approved to Judge Sporting, Working, Terriers, Toys, Herding Groups as well as BIS and is on Permit for Hounds. She has had the great honor of judging both the American National Specialty and the Canadian National Bouvier Specialties. She has had the pleasure of adjudicating in Canada, USA, New Zealand and Australia. She is a member of the CKC. A Breeder of Merit with the AKC and is a member of each the CDJA, ADSJ and DJA. (Dog Judges Associations).

### **CHARLES E. TROTTER**

All-breed judge from Carmel, CA, began his dog-showing career in his home state of Tennessee in 1958 with Afghan Hounds and later German Shepherd Dogs. His homebred Afghans were specialty winners and group winners before he became an all-breed professional handler and concentrated on the dogs of others. He was the zone representative for

the Professional Handlers Association of America before his retirement from handling in 1979 when he began his judging career. Judging assignments have taken Chuck to six continents and all 50 American states. He has judged numerous times at Westminster, including the 2013 Herding Group and the 1997 Working Group, as well as AKC's Eukanuba Invitational and Chicago International.

Well-known for his knowledge of canine movement and anatomical structure, Trotter credits his background in German Shepherd Dogs, Afghans and Norwegian Elkhounds with his theories of proper conformation. Trotter's knowledge and appreciation of correct front-end assembly is legendary. Trotter was the judge of choice for a 21st Century German Shepherd Specialty of more than 100 dogs recently in Beijing.

He is a lifetime member (more than 50 years) of the Nashville Kennel Club and has served two lengthy terms as its president and as an on-going board member as well as show chairman. Chuck retired as president of Mid-South Home Exteriors in 2005 and found that retirement left him busier than ever! For when he is not judging dog shows, he enjoys his motorcycle as well Laguna Seca activities, NASCAR racing, fishing and hunting.

### PATRICIA CRAIGE TROTTER

Registered her first litter of Vin-Melca Norwegian Elkhounds in 1951 and her most recent litter this year. Her breeding program has produced the Top Sire and Dam in the breed's history as well as the breed's top winners. Vin-Melca Elkhounds have won an incredible 10 Hound Group firsts at Westminster, all owner-handled.

When Ch. Vin-Melca's Vagabond became Top Dog All Breeds in 1970, he was the first amateur handled dog to achieve that honor. Pat handled her own dogs to Top Ten All Breed status on 10 different occasions while holding down a full-time teaching job. Her Elkhounds were regular winners of Top Hound honors and Quaker Oats awards. Names such as Vagabond, Howdy Rowdy, Nimbus, Smuggler, Calista, Bombardier, Marketta, Silver Shadow, Top O' The Mark, Margretta, Voyager, Norseman and the current campaigner Delight are amongst the legendary hounds produced by Trotter. Thirty-six different Elkhounds carrying the Vin-Melca name accumulated all-breed BIS honors to date. Today's dogs represent untold generations descending from that 1951 litter.

Pat's achievements began early in her life when Gaines bestowed their Girl Show Dog Fancier of the Year title in 1952. Winkie Awards included numerous honors as Breeder of the Year and Owner-Handler of the Year repeatedly in her campaigning years, and AKC selected her as Hound Group Breeder of the Year in 2004. Other honors include the Hall of Fame (originally Quaker Oats- now ProPlan), and two Fido awards as Dog Woman of the Year and Dog Writer of the Year. Pat's 34 years teaching 8th grade American history in Carmel, California prepared her for her seminar work with presentations based on her book Born To Win. As an AKC Better Breeding columnist, she won the Dog Writers Award for a regular column in an all breed magazine in 1997.

As a judge she focuses on the belief that the true purpose of the dog show is to select breeding stock. She judged the 2009 Westminster Hound Group and the 2012 Best Bred By in Show at the AKC/Eukanuba Invitational as well as the 2014 Best Bred By Family at that event.


### SECTION 8.6.1 & 8.6.3 OF THE CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The authorities of any show may:

- a) decline to accept entries for just cause and/or
- b) refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show building on account of disease or viciousness.
- c) in the case of non-acceptance, the fee shall be returned with the reason for non-acceptance. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the organization holding the show, or any official connected therewith for the refusal of any entry.

### WESTSIDE CENTENNIAL PARK FOR THOSE WITH A GPS THE PARK ADDRESS IS 715 FRANKLIN RD, KAMLOOPS, BC

Directions: From either direction on the Trans Canada Hwy (#1) take exit 374 onto Hwy 5 (Yellowhead) north and turn west onto Halston Avenue (large set of lights - Paul Lake Road goes to the east) then exit right onto the Westsyde Road Access. Travel north on Westsyde Road past Oak Hills Blvd. and Huntingdon Drive, then turn right at the Fas Gas station onto Franklin Road.

### **RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS**

- 1. The club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The show superintendent shall have full control of these shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the show superintendent or veterinarian for any reason shall not, compete in any class for any awards for the balance of the show.
- The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, spectators or vendors.
- 4. Dogs must be on the grounds 1 hour prior to the judging of their breed.
- 5. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 6. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and equipment left at the show grounds.
- 7. Dogs are to be exercised in designated areas only, not in vicinity of show rings
- 8. All recreational units will have buckets underneath for their sink drains. Anyone found discharging water on the grounds will be removed by order of the health department, and may be subject to a fine.
- 9. If, because of civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, there is no refund of entry.
- 10. Dogs must be on leash at all times on the show grounds or within the show building with the exception of the obedience rings.

## ALL EXHIBITORS, HANDLERS AND PATRONS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW AND ABIDE BY THE CKC DOG SHOW RULES CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows;

DOGS COMPETING*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
POINTS AWARDED	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, SHALL NOT be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; (2) a two point win awarded either at the breed or group level; and (3) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

### **EXTRACTS FROM THE CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS**

#### **CHAPTER 4.1.3 - JUDGES**

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

### **CHAPTER 8 - ENTRIES and ENTRY FEES**

#### Section 8.3.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules, as a "listed" dog, provided

- (a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed
- (b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration
- (c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

A listing fee of \$8.40 must accompany the entry of a "listed" dog at a show held under these rules.

#### Section 8.2: INCOMPLETE ENTRIES

Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the wins being cancelled.

### Section 8.6.2: DISHONORED CHEQUES

Tendering of a dishonored cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees. sClubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitor who have been known to tender dishonored cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order, cash or certified cheque.

### **CHAPTER 14 - DISQUALIFICATION**

#### **Section 14.1.4**

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 14, Section 3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations

### **CHAPTER 5 - SHOW OFFICIALS**

#### Section 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

### FOREIGN BORN MINIATURE DACHSHUNDS

Foreign-born Miniature Dachshunds if eligible for registration in the CKC, may be shown as a listed dog up to the age of one (1) year. The owner(s) must then submit an application for registration to the CKC within thirty (30) days. The listing fee for a Foreign-born Miniature Dachshund will be \$2.00 per show. Failure to comply with these rulings will automatically cancel all points on record.

Canadian Kennel Club Non Member Participation Fee (April 2011)

- A non member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC.
- The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by nonmember residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.
