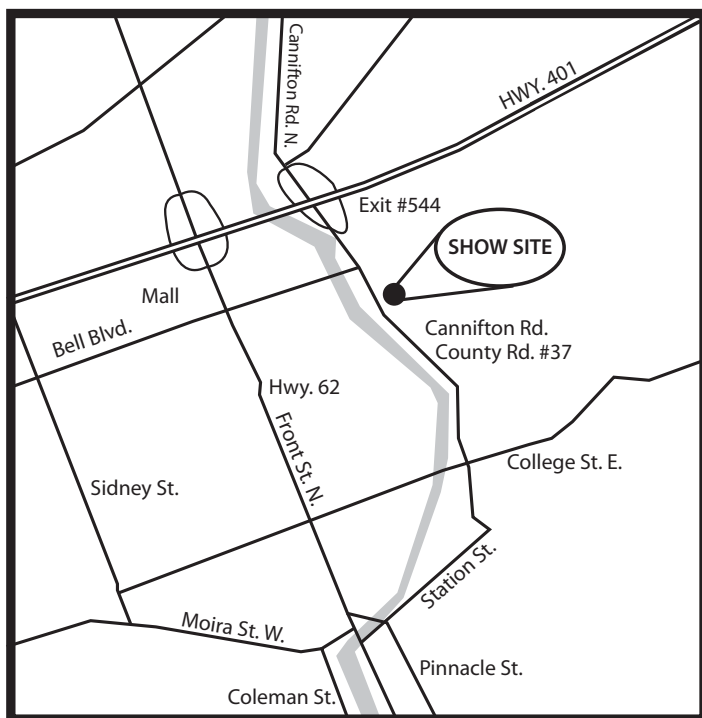

Pre-paid RV/Trailer Parking – Owners must abide by the placement of trailers by the Show Superintendent or delegate. All trailers must be parked in the designated area and in a proper manner as deemed by the Show Superintendent or designate.

A Fee of \$50.00 will be charged for any part of the weekend with Electrical Hook-up. A limited number of electrical hook-ups are available on a first come, first serve, pre-payment basis (no refunds).

Space is designated for units up to 40 feet, excluding tow vehicle. Any larger vehicles must pay for two (2) spaces. Report upon your arrival to a club member. All special requirements must be noted in advance.

NUMBER (ERN)**

Effective Jan. 1/92, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Fee is \$58.50 per dog after January 1, 2012 plus applicable taxes. For further information contact:

Judging Procedure: Judging of the sweepstakes will commence at approximately 12 Noon. However, if necessary, a later starting may be announced for any one or more rings.

CLASSES:
Junior Puppy 6 to 9 Months
Senior Puppy 9 to 12 Months
Open Puppy 12 to 18 Months

RULES & AWARDS:
All dogs between the ages of 6 and 18 months on the day of the Sweepstakes are eligible to compete, regardless of place of birth.

All dogs entered in Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the official classes of the All-Breed show on the day of the Sweepstakes.

Monies received as entry fees will be pooled and divided as follows:

First in each class 30% of the entry fees received for that class
Second in each class 20% of the entry fees received for that class
Third in each class 10% of the entry fees received for that class
Fourth in each class 5% of the entry fees received for that class

Best in Sweepstakes Rosette and 10% of total Sweepstakes entry fees.

The remaining 25% will be retained to cover administration costs.

Held under CKC Rules - Judge to be announced day of show.

Classes:
Pee Wee 4 – 6 yrs. (non-competitive)
Junior 7 – 10 yrs. (Novice and Open)
Intermediate 11 – 14 yrs. (Novice and Open)
Senior 15 – up to but not incl. 18 yrs. (Novice and Open)
Best Overall (excluding Pee Wee)

All dogs must be entered in one of the Official Classes or Exhibition Only on the day of the competition in Conformation.

NOTE: *Pee Wee Competitors must exceed the weight of the dog they are showing.*

CATALOGUES

Catalogues are available on a PRE-ORDER basis. Those who wish to pre-order at a price of \$8.00 may do so by indicating this on their entry form. Your catalogue will be waiting for you at the show. There will be a limited number of catalogues available for \$10.00 at the show.

USA EXHIBITORS

Bank drafts or money orders in Canadian Funds and personal cheques, payable in U.S. funds, and for the full amount of the entry will be accepted. Personally discounted cheques will not be honoured. Please do not mark personal cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as such items are not cleared through the banks. Your cooperation is appreciated.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Effective January 1, 2011:

- A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$58.50 plus applicable taxes.
- The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

GROOMING ROOMS

A limited number of grooming rooms are available.

Space must be reserved from Sandra Esford prior to the closing date.

Rooms must be shared with other exhibitors. When making a reservation, please state the number of dogs entered. A non-refundable deposit of \$30.00 per room will be charged.

A minimum of 10 dogs must be entered before a grooming room can be reserved.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge **SHALL NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.8 A Dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level, save that no more than five (5) points will be credited to a dog for a single show.

Section 15.1.11 A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

Section 15.1.12. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. **Chapter 4- Section 4.7.3** of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. Every day of a 2 or 3 day show is a separate show. Please note that this rule is effective up to one hour prior to the opening of the show, NOT one hour prior to the judging of the breed.

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
3. There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made. Overpayments will be applied to the General Trophy fund.
4. Alterations, substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited, except moving Class Dogs to Specials. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. **Entries positively close 8:00 p.m. WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 8, 2014** and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
5. Identification cards and judging schedules will be emailed/mailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented upon arrival at the show.
6. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. **Any N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a \$35.00 service charge.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules.
2. The Belleville & District Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.
5. Judging will commence at 8 a.m. all three days. A later starting time may be specified in the judging schedule. Starting time of each ring will be specified in the judging schedule.
6. **SHOW PRECINCTS:** The show precincts shall consist of the entire Quinte Sports Centre and an area of 30 feet outside of the judging rings.
7. The building will be open from 7 a.m. on Friday to Sunday. Access to the building for set up will be available after 5 p.m. on Thursday night.
8. **THE ICE SURFACE WILL REMAIN FOR THESE SHOWS. The new floor and insulation will provide a warm and dry building.**
9. An exercise pen will be provided for use in the building. **NO private ex-pens.** In an effort to relieve confusion and crowding at ringside, additional crating space is available upstairs. Please use the main south entrance and the adjacent elevator.
