It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Draft Test regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club (416) 675-5511 or www.ckc.ca.

The Draft Test Committee will exercise due care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs entered but will not be responsible for nor assume any liability in the event of any accident or other misfortune to any dog, exhibitor or patron.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: NEW TRACKING FEE FOR CANADIAN NON-MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC instituted a tracking fee for all Canadian residents who participate in CKC events, but are not CKC members. In order to cover the clerical costs of recording and tracking points and awards earned at CKC events, a participating non-member can choose to purchase a CKC membership or pay a dog specific tracking fee of \$59.40 plus applicable taxes. This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the CKC to efficiently manage recording and tracking points, it is important that non-members select one of the two options within 30 days of notification, or unfortunately, the points, awards and titles will be cancelled.

Eligibility: (section 6.1.1) Draft dog tests shall be open to all purebred dogs of sufficient height and weight that are physically capable of performing all the exercises in a particular class. The judges must excuse a dog at any time during a test for lack of physical capacity. All dogs must be 18 months of age or over on the day of the event.

A Canadian DD is required for the DDX test. A DD is required on both dogs entered in the BDD or a DDX on both dogs entered in the BDDX.

Re-qualifications will be accepted only after all untitled entries are included.

Entry Fee: \$75.00 per dog. A Brace is one entry, please fill out two entry forms and submit together.

- Entry Limit: limited to 7 hours of judging.
- Entries: Entries must be complete, signed and submitted on the official CKC entry form.
- Listing Fee: **\$8.93 per dog** (if the dog does not have an individual CKC number, an Event Registration Number or a Performance Event Number at the time the entry is made, a listing fee of \$8.93 must accompany your entry fee.
- Foreign Dogs: If a dog is not registered individually with the CKC, it may be entered as a "Listed" dog, provided it has an event registration number (ERN), or obtains this from the CKC within 30 days.
- Closing Date: Entries close **Monday, July 20, 2015 at 6:00 pm MDT** or when the limit is reached, even if official closing date has not arrived. A list of alternates will be maintained.

Day of Test Entries: The option of entering on the day of the test will be available for exhibitors if; the test has not reached its stated entry limits, and/or all alternates have been accommodated. **No** bitches in season will be accepted under this provision. Entries will be assessed a **\$25.00 additional fee**, and all fees for this entry will be made in **cash only**. Test entry will be assigned at the end of all the pre-entered dogs. Entry must be received **60 minutes prior to the start time of the test**.

Group Option: The Draft Dog Field Work, Draft Dog Excellent Freight Haul and/or the Draft Dog Excellent Backpacking Exercises may be performed using the Group Option as stated in Section 11.2 using recommended methodology as stated in Appendix A.

Awards and Prizes:

- Each entrant will receive a gift bag
- Each dog receiving a qualifying score will earn a red rosette, per judge, to a maximum of three rosettes
- Each Bernese Mountain Dog qualifying for a new title (DD, DDX, Brace DD, and Brace DDX) will receive a memento from the BMDCC.
- Each Bernese Mountain Dog qualifying for a new title (DD, DDX, Brace DD, and Brace DDX) and the oldest Bernese Mountain Dog qualifying for a new title (DD, DDX, Brace DD, or Brace DDX) will receive a gift courtesy of David and Coral Denis.

Rules and General Information:

Section 17.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, steward, volunteer or competitor at a Draft Dog test is not subject to indignities. The Draft Dog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

Confirmation of Entry: All entrants will be notified of their placement by e-mail only. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis

Refunds: It is the option of the exhibitor to request a refund for a bitch that has come into season, should they desire. A veterinarian's certificate will be required for the refund to be issued.

Bitches In Season: Bitches in season will be allowed to compete, but all exercises will be judged after all other dogs have been tested. Bitches in season must be kept away from the "test site" prior to testing.

Re-qualifications: are acceptable pending "space available". Re-qualifications shall be judged as the last team in the section for which they are entered.
