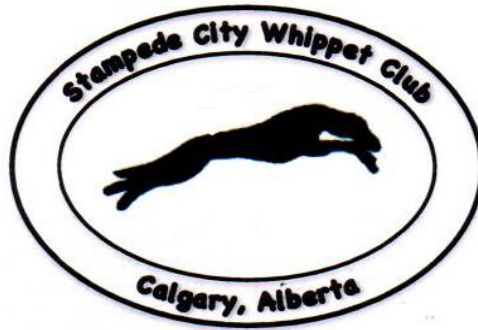

**ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS:** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. I acquired my first Afghan in 1966 from Myia Kennels which was owned by Mary Matchett. My first Whippet also came from Myia Kennels in 1966. I became a member of the CKC in 1967 and am now a life member.

Soon Whippets took over and bred under the prefix Alery. I have bred and owned the breed for most of my life. Managed to produce some very nice dogs over the years and was quite successful showing in Canada and the US. They have indeed been a joy to own and live with. I also showed many other breeds for other people and that was a lot of fun.

I have owned but not bred West Highland White Terriers, Silkies, Min.Poodles, and Lhasa Apsos. My last two Whippets came from Sweden and were with me for 15 years.

I'm very much looking forward to judging your specialty as an Emeritus judge, I think this will be a first for the CKC to allow.

## CLASSIFICATIONS

The following regular CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY	dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show
SENIOR PUPPY	dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show
12-18 MONTHS	dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show
CANADIAN BRED	dogs born in Canada; Champions of any country are excluded.
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class but need not handle the dog for further awards.
OPEN CLASS	for all dogs
VETERAN CLASS	for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). <b>Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered.</b>
FIELD DOG	dogs entered in this class must have attained a title or placement in a field trial or test. This class is to be judged prior to Best of Breed judging with winners of each sex competing for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.
SPECIALS ONLY	dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.

### NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

In order for a dog to be entered in any Non-Regular or Unofficial class, dogs must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

BABY PUPPY	dogs between 4 months and under 6 months on day of show. <b>These puppies are not eligible to compete for championship points.</b>
EXHIBITION ONLY	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes, Veteran and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
EXHIBITION ONLY (4-6 Months)	puppies 4-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only (4-6 Months) <b>provided the Owner also has an eligible dog entered in a Regular Class</b>
BRACE	Two dogs not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Must be handled by one person on one lead and should be judged as an identical pair. Dogs may be spayed/neutered
STUD DOG & GET	Stud Dog and two of his get. Stud Dog and Get may be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition only.
BROOD BITCH & PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two of her progeny. Dam and Progeny may be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition only.

**ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS****ERN - Event Registration Number**

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$59.40 + 5% GST.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.

**\*\* TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBERS (TCN) \*\***

With the implementation of CKC's IT system, a new process requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a *Temporary Competition Number* (TCN). TCNs will replace the current system of entering events with "listed dogs", and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent CKC registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

**A TCN must be obtained BEFORE submitting an entry for any event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered.** Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN or (Canine Companion Number) CCN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called *listing fees*) when entering events using this number.

**The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion.**

Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC via mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

\*\* Please note that if your dog does not have a registration number or ERN, and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores, or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. CKC records will be updated accordingly.

**WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES**

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

An error in an age-specified class, date of birth or sex, may be amended up to one hour before the start of the show.

**Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada**

- To enter Canada from the States, all US Citizens aged 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

**COVID-19 Requirements**

General Required Practices

1. SCWC members, exhibitors and Show Officials are required to follow Federal, Provincial, Local and facility guidelines as presented below. Any changes in guidelines between the posting of this Premium List and the starting of each show will also be followed.
2. Social distancing must be practiced. Maintain a distance of 6 feet / 2 Metres or more unless individuals are part of a family or cohort unit.
3. Masks are required on the show grounds and when showing your dog. Masks are provided by the exhibitors for their personal use. Masks are required in all common areas where social distancing is not guaranteed.
4. Show and Go Rules are in effect – once your breed judging is complete you are required to leave the show grounds and return to your vehicle or your camping spot. Do not enter the show grounds more than 1 hour before your estimated breed start time. No crates or ringside tables are allowed around the rings.
5. There will be plenty of hand sanitizer around the facility for personal use and sanitizer will be provided in the porta-potty
6. Wash hands as frequently as possible. Disinfect gate latches, if touched.
7. No handshakes or hugging.
8. Do not touch dogs that are not your own.
9. Bring your own pen/pencil. No common use pencils, pens or markers will be available.
10. As you park at Wet Noses, leave sufficient space between vehicles to allow for effective social distancing. Information applicable to all participants

General Information

1. The show has been limited to (# TBA) humans on the specialty field at any one time. The (# TBA) human limit applies to entrants, SCWC members and Show Officials and all persons present (including spouse, significant other, family members).
2. Take your win ribbon only if you plan on keeping it. Do not give ribbons back to the SCWC.
3. The show secretary's designated space will be considered sacred ground. Barriers will be set up using a 6 Feet / 2 Metre perimeter to protect the show secretary. Anyone who violates the space of the show secretary will be asked to leave the show grounds and may not return for the duration of the show. No refunds for entries will be provided in this instance.
