Border Crossing: Government regulations require that to be brought into Canada a dog must have a Rabies Certificate. The certificate must be dated at least 30 days prior to re-entry in to the United States.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (Foreign Born/Foreign Owned Dog) For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain Championship status and Obedience Titles and Degrees, individual registration is no longer required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of entering first CKC event to avoid cancellation. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of dogs' foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee (\$59.40 Canadian Funds) along with a letter of request to the CKC. (This ERN number replaces a CKC Individual Registration Number for entering CKC events ONLY.) CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered

<u>JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog *6 months of age and under 9 months of age* on the day of the show

<u>SENIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog *9 months of age and under 12 months of age* on the day of the show

<u>12 to 18 MONTH CLASS</u> – This class shall be for any dog **12 months of age and under 18 months of age** on the day of the show

<u>CANADIAN BRED CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada.(Champions of any country excluded)

<u>BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler <u>MUST</u> be the owner/co- owner <u>AND</u> breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle

the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards **OPEN CLASS** - This class shall be for all dogs

<u>SPECIALS ONLY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. <u>Note</u>: A <u>Listed dog MAY</u> be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class <u>MUST</u> be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE BREED JUDGING ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees <u>WILL NOT</u> be refunded. If a dog is moved to Specials from the Junior Puppy Class exhibitors will lose their Junior Puppy discount.

<u>EXHIBITION ONLY</u> - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class <u>MAY NOT COMPETE</u> in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Any dog entered in a Non-Regular class MUST also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only on the same day.

BRACE CLASS - This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex)

<u>BABY PUPPY CLASS-</u> This class shall be for any dog *3months of age and under 6 months of age* on the day of the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male, Best Baby Female, Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Best Baby Puppy in Group, Best Baby Puppy in Show (*This class will be held on completion of Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and PRIOR to Best Brace in Show)*

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

<u>BEST DOG HANDLED BY A JUNIOR (Jenny Stewart Scholarship Award)</u>- Eligibility for the Best Dog Handled by a Junior competition shall be limited to dogs handled by a junior (18 years old and under) at all levels of judging. Dogs entered in this class must be entered in an official class as well. This class will be judged after the Baby Puppy class except at the Best in Show level where it will be judged after Best Puppy in Show. The judge will pick the best dog, this is not a handling competition.

Eligibility

The Canine Classic is open to all dogs who have ever won a Group 1st in an all breed championship show or complete group specialty held in Canada. The date and location of the group 1st must accompany the entry. Puppy group 1st is not eligible.

Prize List

Best in Classic: **\$500.00** and Rosette - (Sponsored by Savoie Images)

Best Veteran in Classic: \$250.00 and Rosette

Group Winners: \$100.00 and Rosette

Canine Classic Judges

3 secret judges. Two judges will be chosen at random for each group. Winners of the group will be the dog with the highest average score from each judge. At the Best in Classic level dogs will be judged by which ever judge had not previously examined them. (Exhibitors may enter more than one dog per group as they will be entering the rings separately.)

Judging Criterion:

Dogs competing shall be judged in their CKC recognized group in random order. Each group will be judged by two judges without consultation between judges. Each judge will score each dog out of a possible 100 points. The total score awarded will be announced. Individual scores will be posted later. The seven group winners will be judged again individually by a third judge. The dog's three scores will be added together and the highest score will be awarded Best in Classic. In the case of a tie the lowest score of the dogs concerned will be dropped and the new total shall be the deciding factor. If a tie still exists the show committee shall render a decision.

Entry Fee: \$35.00 Entry fee includes a complimentary digital catalogue. Exhibitors may submit a photo and a short description of wins for their dog for submission to the digital catalogue if they choose. Copies of the digital catalogue will be available on our club's website after the show.

Rules

The Canine Classic is an **unofficial event** and is separate from the Alberni Valley Kennel Club CKC approved all breed shows & trials. Catalogues, entries and armbands are separate from those used for the all breed shows.

The Canine Classic will be start at 6:00PM (after BEST In Show) on Sat. October 19th 2019.

Only dogs that have won a group first at an all breed championship show or complete group specialty will be entered.

For **an extra \$5.00 fee** entries will be taken Friday and Saturday (Oct. 18 & 19th) of the show.

NO dog may be entered in the Classic if it has been handled, owned, leased or boarded by any of the classic judges. Exhibitors will be notified by the show secretary if an entry is not eligible.

The show committee reserves the right to remove any person or dog from competition for misbehavior.

The club wishes to express that this is a **FORMAL EVENT and formal attire is requested.**

There will be no refunds of entry fees for any reason.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

15.1.2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: (*Includes the dog awarded Winners.)

Dogs Competing* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more

Points Allocated* 0 1 2 3 4 5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite, Best of Breed. A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Further Section 15.1.12{C} has been added and states the dog must: "have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed level or grouplevel. "The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed below.

A class Dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show.

15.2 Grand Champion (GCh))

- 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Conformation Championship.
- 15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Conformation Championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the Conformation Championship.
- 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
 - a) Grand Champion Point System

Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level:

Best in Show (5 points)

(b) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx)

- 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship title.
- 15.3.2 Points for this title may be accumulated at any time after the completion of the CKC grand championship but does not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship or the grand championship.
- 15.3.3 A minimum of 100 points which must include one Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a Breed National Specialty (where a minimum of ten dogs have competed) plus three group firsts or three Breed Specialty wins.
 - a) Grand Champion Excellent point system

1st in Group or Best in Specialty Show 5 Points

2nd in Group or Best of Opposite Single breed Specialty Show 4 Points

3rd in Group 3 Points

4th in Group 2 Points

(Note: no points are acquired if no other dog is present in the group)

Best of Breed 1 Point

(To earn the breed point, at least 5 dogs must be shown at breed level)

Best in Show or Best in National Specialty Show or Best in Multi Breed Specialty Show 10 Points

- 15.3.4 Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. For example, a dog that wins First in Group and then wins Best in Show, earns 10 points, not 15.
- 15.3.5 The title of Grand Champion Excellent shall not be awarded retroactively. However, dogs that have been awarded the Grand Champion title prior to January 1, 2013, will be awarded the Grand Champion Excellent title on application to the CKC.
- 15.3.7 Additional Requirements: To attain a Grand Champion Excellent title a dog must have been awarded a CKC performance title from any CKC event. A CGN, Herding Tested Certificate or Chase Ability Programs title are not considered performance titles for the awarding of this title.

Non-Member Participation Fee 24-12-3.

- **a**) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a <u>Canadian</u> non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to becanceled.
- c) "These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC

<u>EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBERS -</u> For the sole purpose of entering C.K.C. Events to acquire C.K.C. degrees and titles, individual registration will no longer be required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs. Instead they may apply for an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN). This number must be obtained within 30 days of entry at first Canadian event to avoid cancellation of awards, and can be obtained by submitting A photocopy of your foreign Certificate of Registration and the appropriate fee (currently \$53.50) with a letter of request to the C.K.C. (This ERN number replaces a C.K.C. Individual Registration Number for entering events only).

- 5. THE OWNER OF A DOG ENTERED IN THESE SHOWS IS ENTIRELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ERROR IN ENTERING HIS/HER DOG REGARDLESS OF HOW OR BY WHOM ENTRY WAS MADE.
- 6. EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR DOGS AND EQUIPMENT LEFT AT THE SHOW GROUNDS.
