Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will NOT be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. Post-dated cheques will NOT be accepted. Please DO NOT mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank-you.

BORDER CROSSING – A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada, Government Regulations require a Certificate prior to entry into Canada.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30-day extension to the CKC. An ERN may be obtained by contacting the CKC at: (416) 675-5511 or Fax (416) 675 -6506.

Temporary Competition Numbers

All dogs entered in CKC events that are not CKC registered must have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) before entering into the event(s). This includes Baby Puppies in Conformation shows. Please note that Listed Breeds are not eligible for a TCN (effective July 6, 2021, this includes Baby Puppies). Listed Breeds must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) before entering into an event. The Conformation Show Rules will be updated in this regard.

The Baby Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all English Cocker puppies aged 4 months and under 6 months on the day of the show. All dogs must be entered in the Baby Puppy Non Regular class or Exhibition only in order to enter the Sweepstakes

Baby Puppies will be divided by sex. The Best Male and Best Female will compete for Best Baby Puppy and Best Opposite Sex Baby Puppy in Sweepstakes.

The winner of Best Baby puppy will receive 50% of the entry fees for Baby Puppy Sweepstakes and the Best Opposite Sex Baby Puppy will receive 25% of the entry fees. 25% of the entry will be retained by the Club to defray expenses.

Juvenile Sweepstakes

English Cocker Spaniels

Juvenile Sweepstakes is open to all English Cocker Spaniels 6 months and under 18 months on the day of the show. All dogs must be entered in one of the regular classes.

Dogs will be judged in one of the following 6 classes (divided by sex)

Junior Puppy – 6 months and under 9 months

Senior Puppy- 9 months and under 12 months

Juvenile Puppy- 12 months and under 18 months

For final judging the first-place puppy from each of the classes will be judged together for the awarding of Best in Sweepstakes and Best Opposite in Sweepstakes

Best in Sweepstakes- Rosette and 40% of total fees collected for the Juvenile Sweepstakes
Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes – rosette and 25% of total fees collected for Juvenile Sweepstakes

1st in each class rosette and 10% of total class entry collected

2nd through 4th will receive a rosette.

25% of fees will be retained by the Club to defray expenses

Veteran Sweepstakes

English Cocker Spaniels

Dogs entered in Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the regular official classes. This Sweepstakes class is open to all English Cocker Spaniels from 7 years and over of age on the day of the show. Veteran Sweepstakes will follow the judging of Juvenile Sweepstakes.

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all dogs 7 years of age and entered in a regular breed class or for exhibition only. Spayed and Neutered dogs may compete.

Junior Veteran – 7 years and under 10 years

Senior Veteran – 10 years and under 12 years

Mature Veteran- 12+ years

The final judging for Best Veteran and Best of Opposite in Sweepstakes will include the winner from each of the classes

Best in Veteran Sweepstakes – rosette and 40 % of total fees collected for the Veteran Sweepstakes

Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes – rosette and 25% of total fees collected.

1st in each class, rosette and 10% of fees collected for the class

25% of fees collected will be retained by the club to defray expenses

Junior handling is open to all persons from ages 4 up to 18 years of age on the date of competition. All dogs must be entered in the regular classes or Exhibition only at the Specialty show, but need not be owned by the junior or any of his immediate family.

A rosette and suitable prize will be awarded to the winners of First in each class, flat ribbons will be given to 2nd through 4th in each class.

Peewee handlers will receive a Participant ribbon and prize.

A rosette and prize will be offered for Best Overall.

Championship Points

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

15.1.13 The Board interprets the words “earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges” to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge’s awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

As Of July 2021, The Rules For Awarding Of Grand Champion And Grand Champion Excellent Have Changed. Please See The CKC Conformation Rule Book

15.2 Grand Champion (Gch) & 15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (Gchex) Rules

CONFORMATION: The Following Classes Will Be Provided, Divided By Sex.

REGULAR CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

12-18 MONTH CLASS - for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

OPEN CLASS - shall be for all Dogs. **(It will be divided by Colour, Solid and Particolour)**

SPECIALS ONLY - A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

VETERANS -Veterans will be divided into Males and. Females. Dogs must be 7 years or older on the day of the show. Class will be divided 7- under 10 years, 10 and under 12 years, and 12+. Each class winner will compete for Best of Breed Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

NON REGULAR CLASSES

BABY PUPPY CLASS DOGS 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show.

BRACE- At an all-breed or specialty show a club may, but is not required to, offer a Brace Class. This class shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). A Brace should be judged as an identical pair – same colour, size, gait, and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead

STUD DOG & GET - Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Get must be entered in the regular classes. The stud must be entered in regular classes or exhibition only.

BROOD BITCH & PROGENY - Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. Progeny must be entered in the regular classes. The brood bitch must be entered in regular classes or exhibition only.

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes

Temporary Competition Numbers

All dogs entered in CKC events that are not CKC registered must have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) before entering into the event(s). This includes Baby Puppies in Conformation shows. Please note that Listed Breeds are not eligible for a TCN (effective July 6, 2021, this includes Baby Puppies). Listed Breeds must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) before entering into an event. The Conformation Show Rules will be updated in this regard.

Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled
- c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

EXTRACTS FROM CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

4.7.1 A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty, and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out

19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

Show Officials 5.1.6

The officials of a show-giving club will be held responsible for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators during the show. Any person acting in an objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.3

Entry forms received by the CKC that are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information may result in awards being cancelled.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- a. registered with the CKC
- b. have an Event Registration Number
- c. eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- d. if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN)

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

DISQUALIFICATIONS – SECTION 14.1.4

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Conformation Rule book are available from the CKC, 400 200 Ronson Dr., Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
6. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are **PACIFIC TIME**.
7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 plus GST which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog **BEFORE** taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.
11. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
13. The Club has a zero tolerance of abuse of any description involving any person involved with these shows, including spectators.
