
Maps to Ambertrail

Indignities: It shall be the duty and obligation of the Ottawa Valley Pointing Dog Club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Chairperson shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating this has occurred.

Courses Chukar, pigeons, pheasant or any combination there-of will be used in all field categories. A recognized game bird (duck, chukar, pigeons or partridge) will be used in the FDX water retrieve.

Shooting will be by "Official" gunners only.

FDJ, FD, FDA, FDX and FDXCH courses will be a single course with bird field.

FDJ and FD dogs will be run individually.

FDA, FDX and FDXCH dogs will be run in braces.

FDJ handlers must carry a starter pistol.

For safety, FD, FDA, FDX and FDXCH handlers must wear blaze orange clothing items.

Fees: \$60.00 per entry per day prior to closing date. Day of test entries \$70.

> Fees are payable in Canadian funds only. A listing fee of \$9.50 as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (E.R.N.) is not shown on the entry form.

Entry Close the day of the test or when the limit of 20 dogs/ day has been reached.

Entry is limited to the number of dogs that can be run in daylight hours.

All entries must be paid in full prior to 8 AM – 4th June, 2016. **Bitches in season will be permitted to run at the end of the day. Please inform the test secretary if your bitch is in heat. Please keep your bitch away from the test grounds and keep other handlers and their dogs in mind when dealing with your dog during the day. **

Draw: Running order draw will take place at the home of the Event Chairperson at 9:00 PM 2nd June, 2016. The drawing will be random and specific times cannot be assigned. The owners of the first three dogs to be run on Saturday will be notified by telephone. If two dogs owned by the same person draw consecutive numbers, the second dog will be redrawn. Prizes: The Ottawa Valley Pointing Dog Club will offer rosettes for the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th highest qualifying scores in FDJ, FD, FDA, FDX and FDXCh. CKC Blue Ribbon to each dog with a qualifying score.

The award presentation will take place at the end of the day.

Meals: There will be light lunch & refreshments available on the grounds for a nominal fee. Please support the club by joining us for lunch.

Other: No training of dogs on the grounds during the TEST. It is also recommended that dogs competing have current immunization status. Veterinarian: St. Lawrence Valley Animal Hospital 435 Pitt St. Cornwall, Ontario (613) 932-4094

SPECIAL NOTE: FIELD DOG TEST RULES & REGULATIONS para. 18.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or competitor at a Field Dog Test is not subject to indignities. The Field Test Chairperson shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

NOTE: NEW Paragraph 11.3 It is mandatory that judges, handlers of the working dogs and marshals wear a blaze orange outer garment (vest or jacket) and blaze orange head gear in any tests where shotguns are used. The requirements will also apply to any gallery members on the course.

CKC Non-member Participation Fee

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the nonmember will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

AGREEMENT OF EACH ENTRANT

In consideration of the acceptance of my/our entry (ies) and of the holding of the test and of the opportunity to have the dog tested and to win ribbons or trophies, I/we acknowledge and agree as follows:

- 1) The Ottawa Valley Pointing Dog Club (OVPDC) may refuse any entry for just cause, which the OVPDC deems to be sufficient.
- 2) Field tests have certain inherent dangers associated with them, including, without limitation, those due to the presence and/or use of firearms, and as such any person participating in the test or being present on the test grounds assumes the associated risks.
- 3) To hold the Canadian Kennel Club (the "CKC"), any CKC approved judge, the OVPDC, its members, directors, officers, agents, committee members, test secretary, official gunners at the test and the owners or lessor of the test grounds and any employees of any of them (collectively, the "Club"), harmless from:
 - Any claim for loss or injury which may be caused or alleged to be caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by any act of any dog I have entered in the test, or am responsible for, while in or upon the test grounds, or near any entrance to the test grounds;
 - b) Any claim for loss of any dog I have entered in the test, or am responsible for, by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether the loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury is caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any other person or any other cause or causes;
 - c) For bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting from bodily injuries, sustained by any person or persons, including myself/ourselves, any minors for whom I/we is or are responsible or on account of damage to property arising out of or in consequence of my/our or their participation in the test or presence on the test grounds, however such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not caused or alleged to be caused by negligence of the Club or any of them or any other person; and

I/we personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I/we further agree to assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the Club harmless from any and all losses and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law or a court of competent jurisdiction upon the Club or any of them for any of the foregoing.

I/we agree to be bound by this Agreement of Each Entrant printed in the Official Premium List. I/we certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs.
